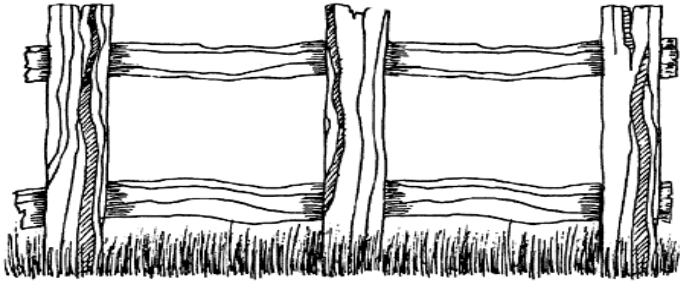

Notes from the Office

There are still many spring packages for pick up at the office....Did you get yours?
This had copies of updated rules, etc. Please pick up if you have not done so.

We have noticed many ATV type vehicles at sites or within the campground. Please remember that ATV's are not to be driven within the campground, although we have allowed them to be driven from the front gate to your site, and from your site out of the campground. No other driving of these vehicles is allowed. If they become a problem, we will need to keep them out of the campground, so please be respectful of the other campers. They are very noisy, so please do not sit and idle them unnecessarily.

A reminder of the speed limit of 10 km/h within the campground. This not only is the speed for you, but your VISITORS and your golf cart as well!

Speaking of visitors, ALL PEOPLE who come on premise needs to have a waiver filled out prior to coming into the gate. This includes visitors who drive in with you, visitors just coming in for a few hours, visitors not staying the night, visitors who are only coming once, visitors with a toddler, visitors just picking something up, etc., etc., etc..... Seriously – if they are human and coming onto Campground property, they need a waiver.

On another note of visitors, please do not park at the front gate and have people walk in to the campground. Your visitors must come during office hours, or arrangements must be made in advance with the office for them to arrive after hours. Please do not give other people your gate card, or let your visitors in with your gate card. Also remind visitors not to block the front gate – that is just annoying!

You can find it on our website, or you would have received it with your spring package – yes, the same spring package I mentioned at the beginning. 😊 Have you picked yours up yet?

Ice Cream Sandwich Cake



- 24 vanilla ice cream sandwiches, unwrapped
- 2 (8 ounce) containers whipped topping, thawed
- 1 (12 ounce) jar hot fudge ice cream topping, warmed
- 1 (12 ounce) jar caramel ice cream topping
- ¼ cup chopped pecans, or to taste

Arrange a layer of ice cream sandwiches in the bottom of a 9x13-inch dish; top with a layer of whipped topping, hot fudge topping, and caramel topping. Repeat layering with remaining ice cream sandwiches, whipped topping, hot fudge topping, and caramel topping, ending with a top layer of whipped topping. Sprinkle with pecans.

Cover the dish with aluminum foil and freeze until set, about 30 minutes.
