

Looking forward to seeing everyone again next season – we will keep you posted where our telescopes will be located.


Notes from the Office



Recipes and Tidbits

One Pot Taco Spaghetti This recipe blends two of our favourites into one quick meal!



Ingredients:

1 tbsp olive oil

1 lb ground beef

½ cup onion, diced

4 ½ tbsp taco seasoning

1 tbsp tomato paste

1 10oz canned diced tomatoes

8 oz spaghetti noodles

3 cups water

½ cup cheddar cheese, shredded

½ cup mozzarella cheese, shredded

Diced roma tomato and fresh cilantro – for garnish

- 1. Heat the olive oil in a large stockpot over medium-high heat. Add the ground beef, onion, and taco seasoning. Cook, breaking up the beef with a wooden spoon, until the meat is browned, 3–5 minutes. Stir in the tomato paste and canned diced tomatoes.
- 2. Add the spaghetti and water. Bring to a boil, then cover, reduce the heat to medium-low, and simmer until the pasta is cooked through, about 15 minutes.
- 3. Remove the pot from the heat and add the cheddar cheese, mozzarella cheese, diced Roma tomato, and cilantro. Stir until the cheese is melted.
- 4. Serve immediately, garnished with more Roma tomato and cilantro, if desired.
- 5. Enjoy!
