




Getting to know Linda Valiquette By Pat Smith

Linda Valiquette has always been known by others as a 'rassembleuse', a French word meaning someone who gathers people together. That ability is one of the special talents she has developed throughout her life, and it is certainly a very important aspect of her life here in the Meadows.

Linda was born in Ste-Adele in the Province of Quebec, Canada, located in the lower Laurentians, just north of Montreal, and was the eldest of three, having a brother and sister who she felt were her responsibility. Until she was 10, she lived beside a popular resort, Le Chantecler, where her father worked. She credits her access to free skiing, swimming, and sports at the resort with her lifelong interest in exercise and health.

But in 1965 her father moved the family to Dorval when he was hired at the new Montreal Airport, and for Linda this was the best day in her life. She settled into a brand-new school and continued to make close friends throughout her high school years. She still sees many of these friends and makes a great effort to maintain her early friendships.

At 16, Linda took courses for teaching and social work but was still undecided on a career when she accepted a job as a Flight Attendant at Air Canada. She was to work for them for 37 years in many roles, including staff training, public relations and as a Flight director. During her time with Air Canada, she also acquired a bachelor's degree in nursing, studied law, and did a two-year exchange with Swissair, who had very high standards for passenger experience.

Because her job required only 10-12 days working a month, Linda was able to establish a second home in Florida when her parents moved here in 1993. So, her life for 10 years was hectic but exciting with layovers in big cities, vacations to favorite destinations, often taking friends, and shuttling between Canada and Florida. She now has no bucket list for travel which isn't surprising!

On one of her trips back from Montreal in 2003, Linda was walking through the Dorval airport when a past acquaintance from 20 years before recognized her blond hair and her voice. "Are you Linda Valiquette?" he asked, and when he introduced himself as Robert Tartre, she remembered him. He took her phone number, but she didn't take his.

Fast forward 2 years, Robert had lost Linda's phone number, then found it by accident in a misplaced work file but got no answer when he called. He didn't give up and on a business flight to Calgary, he passed letters for Linda through the Air Canada flight attendants and eventually these reached Linda in January 2005. They talked for 2 hours on the phone and Linda's mother insisted she invite him to visit them in Florida. After spending 10 very joyful days, knowing they might never have found each other, they decided they should not waste their remaining years. They married in 2007,

Linda retired in 2009 and Robert in 2010 and they looked for a place here in South Florida to enjoy their winters. They found the Meadows in 2012. It fit their needs perfectly good location, swimming pool, tennis court, and a strong sense of community. Both Linda and Robert love to teach people what they know, particularly in sport and fitness, so before long Robert helped in setting up pickleball here in the Meadows and taught anyone who wanted to learn. Linda meanwhile had taken over the morning exercise program, which then became the pool Aquafit program, and has now added chair yoga to her busy day.

So, if you take part in any morning exercise here at the Meadows be grateful that Linda has always had a desire to help others, to bring joy through gathering people together and had the good fortune to run into the perfect man for her.

- 4. Remember that you are only allowed to place objects, trees, or bushes within the 3- or 5-foot areas against your home **after architectural approval**.
- 5. Do not place anything on the outside of your home without an **approved architectural** form.
- 6. We all purchased our homes here because of the way it looked as our first impression. Help us keep it that way.


