# Getting to Know Josephine Lojewski

I sat down with Josephine Lojewski who was born and raised in Norwich, NY, the only girl and the oldest of four including three brothers. The surviving brother is another Meadows resident, Jim DiNoto. Her father was Sicilian, born in Siracusa, Sicily, but her mother was the more outspoken parent. Josephine knew how to handle her father—a trait that would serve her well.

Josephine graduated from high school with a concentration of Business Classes. She worked part-time in school and after graduation put herself through Business School. Josephine went to work for a lawyer but she wanted more. “I looked at myself and said is this all there is?” She began to look around at other opportunities. Military service appealed to Josephine. A career totally different for a woman.

It was at this point that her mother stepped in and said, “Why don’t you stay home and find yourself a nice Italian man?” Her father was OK with it. He trusted his daughter’s decision.

And so, the next chapter began. Josephine joined the WAF and did her Basic Training in San Antonio, Texas. After Basic Training, Private DiNoto was sent to school to take additional business classes.

Assigned to Westover AFB in Westover, MA, PFC DiNoto worked in Personnel and enjoyed the camaraderie of her fellow air force men/women.

About a year later, she received orders to report to Washington, DC. Josephine had no idea where she would work in DC until she was actually settled in. Finally, she found herself no longer living in a barrack. Now she had a single room.

To her surprise, she was assigned to the Pentagon working for an AF Colonel and two

AF Majors! “I loved it!! I loved working for officers and enjoyed city life. After all, I was only 22.” The young Josephine quickly moved up the ranks from Private to Staff Sergeant.

While in the WAF, Josephine and her brother took a trip to their father’s homeland in Sicily to meet the family. And of course, spoke Italian!

As years passed, and her tour of duty was up, ‘what will I do next,’ and again her mother was ready with an answer. “You always wanted to go to college so go!” Josephine did just that and enrolled in SUNY Albany. She graduated with a BS in Business Education and taught Business Subjects for three years in Albany, NY. While teaching, she attended night school to earn her MBA. Josephine went from Business Teacher to Guidance Counselor.

While busy working and attending school, she lost her first husband and found herself alone with his six-month old baby girl. About six years later, she met Alfred Lojewski and he had a son and daughter. “The most important part of my life was raising our family. At no time was it ever yours or mine, the children were always OURS.”



Her parents moved to Fort Lauderdale and the family visited for holidays, etc. Alfred and Josephine found the Meadows attractive and moved here in 1984. Sadly, Alfred passed at age 58. Josephine worked another ten years as a Guidance Counselor. “I lost two husbands and two brothers but I feel so lucky to have my children; grandchildren; Jim and Pauline; and daughter-in-law in my life.”

With a prestigious and varied career path that spanned 35 years including service to our country and our youth, our 55+ year-old Josephine enjoys the amenities of life here at The Meadows including daily walks, Bridge, the pool, etc. Her cadre of friends include Lillian another Meadows neighbor. “Josephine and I look out for each other.” That’s what Meadows’ residents do!

Please remember to place your Bulk Trash out for pick up on Monday evening. **NOT BEFORE...** Placing trash or Bulk trash out too early is simply not allowed. Bulk Trash pickup is scheduled for every Tuesday; if the city has an overload of trash or a city holiday the bulk trash may be delayed one day until Wednesday, they are very dependable and it will be picked up.

If you are doing Construction, please have your handyman doing the job haul the construction material away. You may not place "construction material" out for pick up. The City of Deerfield Beach will not allow this, you will most likely see the paperwork attached - with a charge. The city will charge the homeowner for picking up your construction material at a later time.
