Halloween is a holiday celebrated each year on October 31, and the Halloween origins date back to the ancient Celtic festival of <u>Samhain</u> (pronounced sow-in). The <u>Celts</u>, who lived 2,000 years ago, mostly in the area that is now Ireland, the United Kingdom and northern France, celebrated their new year on November 1. The Celtics people would light bonfires and wear costumes to ward off ghosts. In the eighth century, Pope Gregory III designated November 1 as a time to honor all saints. Soon, All Saints Day incorporated some of the traditions of Samhain. The evening before was known as All Hallows Eve, and later Halloween.

This day marked the end of summer and the harvest and the beginning of the dark, cold winter, a time of year that was often associated with human death. Celts believed that on the night before the new year, the boundary between the worlds of the living and the dead became blurred. On the night of October 31, they celebrated Samhain, when it was believed that the ghosts of the dead returned to earth. Over time, Halloween evolved into a day of activities like trick-or-treating, carving jack-o-lanterns, festive gatherings, donning costumes and eating treats.

TO ALL THE HOMEOWNERS IN THE MEADOWS:

FIRST, I WOULD LIKE TO APOLOGIZE TO YOU FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE BOARD AT THE SEP 13 MEETING. THE ONGOING PROBLEM IS AND HAS BEEN A LACK OF COMMUNICATION BETWEEN BOARD MEMBERS. FOR THE LAST 5 MONTHS THE MAJOR PROBLEM HAS BEEN A NEW CABLE CONTRACT. AS A SMALL BUSINESS OWNER (7 CORPORATIONS) OVER THE LAST 30 YEARS, I HAVE THE EXPERIENCE OF SIFTING THRU BIDS AND DETERMINING THEIR GOOD AND BAD FEATURES. THE ONLY GOOD FEATURE OF THESE TWO BIDS IS A MINIMAL DECREASE IN THE PRICE. GETTING TO KNOW LUCILLE KERR

Lucille Kerr was born in Stockbridge, Michigan, 99 years ago. With twelve years between Lucille and her older brother, her parents were looking into adoption and along came Lucille. Their parents raised them well, instilling the importance of consideration and manners especially to older people.

Lucille finished both grade school and high school and went on to earn a degree at Lansing Business University. She went to work at Michigan State University in Personnel but spent the majority of her years there working as a secretary in the Landscape and Architecture Department. Lucille was good with numbers!

She married her high school sweetheart and they had a son, but that marriage did not last long. Time passed, and Lucille was to meet and marry a military man and became good friends with his family. She was deeply affected by the passing of her brother-in-law on the USS Arizona during the



attack on Pearl Harbor, the event which signaled the entry of the US into WW II. Lucille's husband was to eventually pass away with cancer.

Later, a friend introduced Lucille to Leo Kerr. The couple married and Leo legally adopted the three sons, Phillip, Robert, and John, and lovingly cared for his family for close to 50 years until he passed at a relatively young age.

Both husband and wife worked for the Miami-Dade School District, which became the largest school district in the country. Leo was already working there as the Superintendent of Buildings and Grounds when he became the Executive Director of Purchasing. Lucille became the Executive Secretary to the Superintendent of Schools for 20 years. The boys grew up in Miami, and recall the teamwork of parental support during their formative years. Lucille and Leo were active in Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts. They went deep sea fishing as a family, and camping trips on their way to Michigan each summer to visit their grandmother. From horticulture to track fields and folk lore, Leo and Lucille encouraged it all. Phillip, Robert, and John's careers mirrored their early years.

Once the couple retired, they heard about The Meadows from relatives and settled here where they were involved in The Meadows social scene. The three sons grew to be exemplary young men and to this day travel from North Carolina and Colorado to be with their mother. Each month, one son arrives and when he leaves, the next month the next son arrives and so the cycle goes. Then COVID was upon us and that brought an interruption to this cycle. As neighbors, we tried to offer help. When one of us would ask, Lucille said it was all covered. Her sons arranged to have their mother's meals, groceries, prescriptions, etc., all delivered. What a beautiful testament to the power of parental love and devotion. And RARE to have sons so willing to care for their mother. The boys were raised with the same principles passed down from their mother and father.



In closing, Mary Anne Reed tells me that Lucille personally delivered her HOA dues up until a couple of years ago and picked up her own mail. Independent and strong, she cares for herself with a little help and enjoys her lovely home with its beautiful view of the lake. Not content to just sit, Lucille is an avid reader and does a daily crossword puzzle. There is an organ and a piano in her home and Lucille enjoys playing the piano every day. "I don't want to forget, there is too much to remember. Life is interesting. It has been good to me. I survived losing a lot of loved ones, **BUT I STILL HAVE MY THREE SONS."**

What a beautiful outlook on life, loss, and what it takes to keep moving it forward!




