Hello residents New and Old. We start the new year with a re-elected Board of Directors and a new face in Tony Guadagnino (Tony G). The Board is also reviewing applicants for an appointment to the vacant seat left by our Friend Al Levy.

Your Board has entered into a new Bulk Agreement with Comcast / Xfinity.

Under the new Bulk agreement, Comcast will provide both High-Definition Cable TV, with X/1 Voice Remote with 150 hours of DVR, AND Performance Wi-Fi High-Speed Internet Services, which will be included in your maintenance fees at NO ADDITIONAL COST. Still Keeping our monthly maintenance below \$200 a month with this and all our great amenities.

The Upgraded Bulk services will be deployed and available to all homes within the community sometime in April 2022, although we do not have an exact date as of yet. At that time your Comcast / Xfinity monthly invoice will go away unless you have premium channels like HBO, Showtime and the like.

We will provide you with additional updates when more information is provided to us by Comcast / Xfinity.

The plumbing project is underway with very little disruption to our office or club house activities.

Along those lines because of the growing concern over Covid-19 and the several variants. We have a Mask requirement for our buildings. Also, there are No community activities planned for the next 30 days. Stay Safe!

Getting to know Thomas Broad

This month you will be getting to know Tom Broad, a husband, a father of five, an Army Veteran, and a resident of the Meadows of Crystal Lake. Tom was born April 30, 1930 in Cheektowaga, New York (a suburb of Buffalo). He was one of five children. As a young man Tom was always hard working. He remembered how his family wasn't rich, but he doesn't remember ever being hungry. His extended family lived in the area and each had a small farm. Each farm grew something different, and the families shared in the tough times.

Tom recalled having a large daily paper route plus a larger Sunday route of 200 papers. Tom said, "I was making more than my dad." Each payday Tom would go home and give all his earning to his mom because that's what families did. As Tom got a little older, he earned money working games and concession booths at church and Volunteer Fireman Picnics. These picnics were organized by the local volunteer fire houses or churches and Tom would organize a group of family and friends to go from town to town and work at the picnics.

Tom's mother passed away in 1947 from cancer. As Tom put it, it was before most people knew what cancer was. His father died in 1952 from a heart attack.

In February 1952 Tom enlisted in the Army and did his Basic Training at Fort Dix, New Jersey before



being sent to the War in Korea. On St. Patrick's Day 1953 Tom was gravely wounded by a mortar. He recalled how he heard the "whistling" sound of the mortar overhead; he brought his arms up to protect his face; the explosion and the pain on the left side where the shrapnel entered through his ribs, and into his lung. Tom was awarded the Purple Heart and a Bronze Star for his service in Korea.

After his military service Tom attended The University of Buffalo where he earned a degree in Chemistry. For the next 12 years years Tom used his degree in chemistry and his hard work ethic to advance from new hire to Chief Chemist and Plant Supervisor at a large company.

During that same time Tom married and began raising a family. He and his wife, Vicki, were married for 59 years and raised five children, four boys and one girl.


Tom shared how proud he was of all of his kids, and how the two oldest boys were Eagle Scouts. That reminded him of how his time as a Boy Scout had prepared him for the military. He told how GIs returning from WWII were the Scout Leaders when he attended a Scout Camp one Summer. The GIs were no nonsense guys that had the Scouts doing everything the military way. Tom said, "When I got to Basic Training, I knew how to do what they were teaching us, so they put me in charge of the other recruits."

After 12 years as a chemist, Tom made a career change and became an appraiser. He did that in the Buffalo area until his wife, Vicki, was offered a job at Cape Canaveral, Florida in 1989. With that he relocated to the Titusville area of Florida and continued working as an appraiser. Vickie died in 2009 of a heart attack.

Tom met his current wife, Gail, in church in Hendersonville, North Carolina. They have been married for eight years. Gail has a son-in-law that is a Realtor in Coral Spring, and that is how Tom and Gail came to find the Meadows of Crystal Lake.

When asked about the highs and lows in his life, Tom was quick to say meeting Gail and raising his family with Vicki were the highs. The lows were getting wounded in Korea and a head on collision with a tractor trailer that left him in a coma for 13 days.

As far as advice, Tom said, "Never leave a job until you have a job, you're much better off looking for a job when you still have a job."


