Memorial Day Observance at the Meadows

Our annual Memorial Day Observance Ceremony will be held on Monday, May 30th at 11am at our Veterans Memorial Flagpole.

All residents of the Meadows are invited to attend and honor all those men and women who gave their ultimate sacrifice in the service of our country. All Meadows Veterans are invited to wear their branch of service caps or insignias and gather around the flagpole to be recognized for your service.

The Social and Travel Club will host light refreshments after the service. This is a rain or shine event and we are looking forward to a great show of support.

Since May contains two of the three U.S. national holidays that recognize members of its military, it seems like a great opportunity to remind everyone that each day is distinctly different.

Armed Forces Day, observed on the third Saturday of May, celebrates and honors all those **currently serving** as members of the Country's Armed Forces. It's the perfect time to congratulate any uniformed military member and thank them for their service.

Memorial Day, until 1971, was observed on May 30th. Now it is celebrated on the last Monday of May. It was originally proclaimed as **Decoration Day** immediately following the Civil War, and was a holiday "for the purpose of strewing with flowers, or otherwise decorating the graves of comrades who died in defense of their country." Following World War I, the focus of the holiday was expanded to remember and honor **all** members of the military who **died serving** their Country in any conflict.

Getting to Know John Murphy By Bill Jeffries

John Murphy is a man with no but. You know what I mean. People say something about a man or woman that is complementary and then say "but". "He's real smart "but" and then something not so complementary. Well, with everyone I spoke to in the Meadows that has met John, they say the nice thing and none of them ever continued on with the "but". This is the story of John Murphy, the man without a but, after his name.

John was born on February 16, 1940 in Flushing, New York. He had two older brothers and an older sister and later would have a younger brother. His father was a Letter Carrier and along with his mother they also owned a Stationary Store in Bayside, New York where the family lived. John went to Saint Luke's Catholic School in Whitestone, N.Y. and always was more interested in baseball than school work. He remembers loving the Brooklyn Dodgers until they left for Los Angeles and then falling in love all over again with the New York Mets.

Carole, John's first wife, and John were in the same kindergarten class and they also had the same street address, just on different streets. Carole lived just around the corner from John and he never really noticed her until the seventh grade. Starting in the seventh grade John noticed the pretty girl from just around the corner. They became friends, boyfriend and girlfriend, and got married. They were married for 54 years. They had four girls and one son. Carole passed away in 2010 from emphysema and COPD. John remains very close with all of his children. Weekly phone calls with each are the norm to help John stay informed on what is going on in the lives of his 11 grandchildren and 16 great grandchildren.

As a teen John remembered always having a job. He recalled in 1956 he had 12 jobs in one year. Most were in retail. He would get hired and as the workload diminished the last guy hired was the first let go. So, he had to hustle and find a new job. With great references and a good attitude, he kept finding work. John's professional career was also in retail. One of his early ventures was with Dugan's House to House Bread and Cakes, which lasted two years. That was followed by four years with the Frito-Lay Company, and that was followed by another 4 years with the Treat Potato Chip Company.

These jobs all lead John to work for Clare Rose Distributor, the Anheuser-Busch Distributor in Long Island, New York. This employment lasted 31 years, 14 years as a driver/salesman and 17 years as management. This company was a good fit for John who was always up for a challenge. One year the company's sales contest prize was \$1,500 and a trip to Europe. John's eldest daughter and her husband were stationed in Germany with the Air Force and she was due to have John and



Carole's first grandchild later that year. You guessed it. John won the prize and about a week after their first grandchild (a girl) was born the proud grandparents were there to hold the newest member of the family. John met Audrey at the Elks Club in Pompano Beach. Each had gone with friends and during introductions they found that each lived at Century Village. They became friends and sometime later John told Audrey that he made a great omelet and she should stop by some morning and he would make her one. She did. John and Audrey have been married for eight years.

When asked how they came to live in the Meadows, John told how he and Audrey came over to visit Joan and Bernie Engert, friends of his and Carole's from Long Island, New York. Audrey fell in love with the community, and they have lived here for the last 10 years.

The purpose of the rear parking lot is to provide "Short Term" parking spaces for residents and visitors. "Short Term" should be limited to **one or two days** without the car being moved from the lot.

"Long Term" parking arrangements are provided for in the front parking lot, and set up through the Office.

RULES:

- -Park only in marked spaces
- -NO RV'S Trailers or Commercial Vehicles
- -Must Back into spaces (Backing into spaces makes it easier to check Note on Dashboard) PROCEDURES:
- -Resident opens rear lot gate with Pool Key
- -The lock must be relocked before the key can be removed
- -Resident or guest backs car into open space.
- -Resident and/or guest leaves a Note on dashboard of car, with Lot #, & date.
- -Resident and/or guest leave, locking parking lot gate




