Getting to Know Bill Jeffries

In advance of Veterans' Day (the 11th day of the 11th month), The Meadows Action Newsletter thought it fitting to interview a career military Veteran.

Most Meadows' residents know Bill Jeffries as the affable and efficient HOA Secretary and former HOA President. But before he arrived in our community, he spent over 20 years serving in the U.S. Navy, retiring in 1992 as a Chief Petty Officer.

A Los Angeles-area native, Bill enlisted in the Navy in 1972 after graduating from Cal State Fullerton (California) with a degree in journalism. He became an Interior Communications Electrician, basically responsible for all communications from one piece of equipment to another "within the skin of a ship." He was mostly embarked aboard auxiliary ships that carried ammunition, bombs, missiles, fuel, and the like to resupply combat ships deployed at sea.

During his career he deployed to the Western Pacific Ocean and Indian Ocean multiple times. These deployments usually lasted six to eight months and often included port calls in Japan, the Philippines Islands, South Korea, Singapore, Hong Kong, Australia and Diego Garcia. Not each port was visited on every West-PAC deployment, but the variety of ports helped break up the weeks of "steaming" from one ocean location to another resupplying other ships.



Bill also had the opportunity to sail on two Mediterranean deployments. The first was on a warship that specialized in hunting for Soviet submarines. During that deployment his ship was part of the battle group that had our jet fighters shoot down two Libyan mig's. He also had great port calls in France, Italy, Yugoslavia, Turkey. and a trip through the Suez Canal. The other deployment was in support of Desert Storm in (1990-1991) where the repair ship he was on provided repair services to other deployed ships in the Saudi Arabian area.

Ashore, Bill worked with Armed Forces Radio & Television Services in Hollywood, California. There he recorded TV programs for rebroadcast to the Fleet. (This was before program signals were routinely bounced off of satellites.)

It was while he was at AFRTS in 1978 that he met Jaymme, a pretty, young girl who lived next door in the same apartment complex. He would see her going to work while he was lounging at the pool after finishing the overnight shift. They married in 1979 and have two grown children. A son Shawn in Coral Springs, Florida and a daughter Kymberley in Hampton, Virginia.



After retiring from the Navy, Bill enrolled in Old Dominion University where he earned a Masters of Education in 1994. He then spent the next 21 years teaching special needs children in Portsmouth and Chesapeake, Virginia. He retired from teaching in 2015.

Bill and Jaymme moved to The Meadows in 2019, from Chesapeake, Virginia. They are active participants in bingo, the Veterans Club, Geocaching and all of the social events at the Meadows, when they aren't indulging their passion for shipboard cruising. Guess you can take the sailor out of the ocean, but not the ocean out of the sailor. When asked how he is doing Bill answers, "I'm livin' the dream."

Thank you for your service, Bill.




