Getting to know Roseanne Messina By Bill Jeffries

Born in New York City in the early 1940s, this month's featured resident, Roseanne Messina, is always prepared for the unexpected changes that life might send her way. She was the youngest of two girls in a New York family where the parents owned and operated a department store and delicatessen. After being robbed a couple of times, the family sold the business and moved to the smaller and more peaceful town of Tivoli, New York. This happened around the time when Roseanne was about seven years old. Her parents opened a general store and delicatessen in their new hometown.

The town of Tivoli was a "sleepy little town" according to Roseanne. The town was small with no movie theater or bowling alley. She and her sister attended a private religious school through eighth grade. To show how small the school was, Roseanne said, "First, second, and third grades were in one room, fourth and fifth in another, and sixth, seventh, and eighth in the last. I was one of three graduates in my eight-grade class." Roseanne remembers not really liking the country life in upstate New York. She said, "My best friend lived a half a mile away, but things got a little better when I could ride my bike to my friend's house."

Roseanne attended Red Hook Public High School in Red Hook, New York. Her favorite subject was French. She wanted to take Italian, but it was not offered. She decided that French was the next best thing. Her graduating class of 33 students visited Washington, D.C. for their "Field Day", and that trip may have reminded Roseanne of how much she liked big city life. After graduation she continued her French studies at Secretarial School in New York City.

Upon graduation from Secretarial School Roseanne was quickly hired by P. Lorillard Tobacco

Company because they needed a secretary that could translate French. After a couple of years, she moved back to Tivoli. She was hired by IBM in Poughkeepsie, N.Y. Roseanne recalled that after a major snowstorm she transferred back to New York City. She said, "In New York you can do 'fun stuff' like dancing at the Roseland Ballroom."

While living in the city she was introduced to Don, who would become Roseanne's first husband. He was a reservations agent for Pan American Airways.



They lived in Brooklyn for a year but after a vacation in Miami, the young couple decided living in the Sunshine State was in their future. Both arranged job transfers and soon they were living in Miami Springs, Florida. Soon after moving to Florida the couple bought a house. Roseanne said, "I realized we could sell the house, buy a duplex, and rent one side and live in the other. They did this for a few years until they moved to Coconut Creek. They were blessed with two daughters, Lisa and Andrea. After nine years of marriage the couple divorced.

Roseanne married for the second time in 1978. Harry Messina was the lucky man and the owner



of a marina business. They worked as a team at the marina and traveled the world for 31 years while they lived in Coral Springs. In 2009, with plans to downsize, Roseanne and Harry moved into the Meadows of Crystal Lake. "We were driving around on Memorial Day and saw people coming out of a party here at the Meadows. Everyone was so friendly and happy; we knew we wanted to live here." said Roseanne.

Harry passed away in 2016. Roseanne served on the Board of Directors as Secretary and worked on the Welcome Wagon. Currently she has organized a Ladies on Group that goes monthly on outings to a local restaurant. When asked for words of

If you make your payment late and do not include the \$25 you will receive a notice in themail asking to please remit late fee.

2.Click on Send

3.Search for the Association of the Meadows of Crystal Lake. You may have to add the Association of the Meadows of Crystal Lake as a new contact.

4.Enter email themeadows2300@gmail.com

5.Enter payment amount.

6.Click Review

7.On the reason line enter the reason for your payment and your lot #

8.Click Send.

The office will receive an email as a record of your payment. The office will give you a receipt if you need it.

Using Zelle is not mandatory, it's just a new tool to make your payments without coming to the office.


