### Getting to know Gary and Linda Treichler By Bill Jeffries

February is the month for loving couples, and no other couple better exemplifies this than Gary and Linda Treichler. They have been married nearly 62 years and are proud parents of three adult children.

Gary was born in Niagara Falls, New York and has a younger sister and two older brothers. Linda was born a few miles away in Lockport, New York with two older brothers and a younger sister. As a child Linda remembers her father owning a gas station and garage. She also recalled helping around the house and picking apples every summer.

When Gary was growing up, he remembered, "working on the farm." He also remembered each summer with his grandfather taking him, "about four hours away to the family cottage in Canada to fish." He continued, "The water was so clean, and you knew it was clean, because the loons won't come unless the water is clean." Gary remembers the cottage not having running water, electricity, indoor plumbing, or a phone. The only way to get there was by boat or hike in if the water was too rough. Gary and Linda still own the family cottage on the lake in Canada. Now it has electricity, indoor plumbing, and access by road as well as by boat.

Gary and Linda's brothers had been friends for some time, so Linda and Gary knew each other. On Linda's 18th birthday Gary and Linda went on their first date. Three months later they were married and as they say in the movies, "The rest is history." This March it will be 62 years of history. Woven into that history are three adult children, a daughter Tammy, and sons Todd and Terry. Between them they have blessed Gary and Linda with five grandchildren and four great grandchildren.

At the center of this happy family is "The Farm" a 227-acre greenhouse and nursery farm in Sanborn, New York. It is in western New York, east of Buffalo and has been in Gary's family since 1854. Gary has worked on the farm his entire life. Now, it is a greenhouse and nursery, but in years past they raised potatoes, asparagus, cabbage, corn, celery, and even raised 100 head of grain fed beef cattle.

For 35 years Linda was a hairdresser. They added a beauty parlor to the back of the main house so she could work from home, because in addition to being a hairdresser she kept the books for the farm business. Now their daughter, Tammy runs the beauty parlor and Todd's son takes care of the bookkeeping for the greenhouse business. Son, Terry runs the greenhouse while son Todd, retired from UPS, works there as well. The business employs six people full time and 23 as seasonal employees. The season runs from February first until the last day of October each year, a full nine months.

Linda and Gary moved to the Meadows in 1999. For several years prior to that they had been coming down to the Meadows during the football season playoffs with four other couples. Gary remembered, "There were 17 Buffalo area families living in the Meadows." On one of the trips, "a friend bought three houses in one day. The next day he bought four more to sell to other friends." said Gary.

That prompted Gary and Linda to start looking for a place of their own to buy. A lawyer that lived here was interested in selling and wanted to leave all the furnishings except, a baby grand piano, a desk, and his clothing. That was perfect for Linda and Gary who were interested in being "snowbirds" and not wanting to furnish a house right away. So, Gary wrote him a check and that sealed the deal.

When asked for words to live by, Gary offered: "Keep working. If you stop, you rust, if you rust, you're done."






