<u>Getting to know Grace Burritt</u> <u>By Pat Smith</u>

Many people in the Meadows know Grace. That's not surprising - she has wintered here for 30 years, and she has acquired the affectionate nickname of Amazing Grace. You will see her often at the pool, doing laps, in the Aquafit class, or socializing with her many friends. You will see her heading out for golf or dinner, and if you are invited into her home, you will see a trumpet proudly hanging on the wall.

Grace was born as Grace Mowatt in 1937 and grew up on a pleasant street in Kenmore, a suburb of Buffalo. She was the youngest of five, with one sister and 3 brothers. Her eldest brother fought in WW2 while Grace was still in kindergarten, but she was close to another brother with whom she enjoyed fishing and playing catch to match his interests. In High School, Grace loved competing in Synchronized swimming which was one of the few sports that had female competition at that time.

She knew when it came time to think about a career that she wanted to teach Phys Ed since she loved athletics and loved working with kids. She went to Cortland, a SUNY College, for her degree, and one of the highlights of her education was a graduate course in Comparative Education. This course saw her travel with her classmates and professors to Europe for 71 days one summer for \$2,000, visiting Phys Ed programs in schools in England, Denmark, Belgium, Germany, France, and Austria, ending in Rome in time for them to attend the Olympics.

As a newly qualified Phys Ed teacher, Grace started in a Junior High School in Kenmore. She loved the exuberance of the kids in this grade, but class sizes started getting too big for safety.

From Junior High, Grace moved to Oswego College. She says they hired her for her Synchronized swimming ability since they had an annual water show which she organized. At this time in 1963, women did not have any competitive sports programs even at college. Not until 1970 and the passing of Title 9 did women's sports start developing, and Grace was very involved with this process. She was very active on college committees which was how she got to know a talented music professor called Hugh Burritt. He had been to Juilliard to study, and as a jazz musician had backed such stars as Tony Bennett and Nat King Cole. In fact, his first date with Grace was at a Jazz Concert in Alexandria Bay. They were married 2 years later in Letchworth State Park, New York, serenaded by a visiting Welsh choir.

Hugh had always wanted to retire to Florida and so after their teaching careers ended, he bought the house in the Meadows, near his sister at Discovery Pointe. Grace kept her



house in Oswego, and they became snowbirds. They traveled and explored in an RV, and even went on a cruise with 65 other residents from the Meadows. Hugh played regularly with his jazz band and performed for the last time at the Meadows New Years Eve party. He passed away in 2018.

Grace has always kept her life very full. She was a competitive golfer, then a recreational one, and for many years volunteered at the Honda Classic Golf Tournament as



well as with Horses and the Handicap Association. Grace has a great sense of humor, loves to tell jokes, and has a very positive attitude toward life. Oh, and she's a romantic. Remember I told you about Hugh's trumpet.
