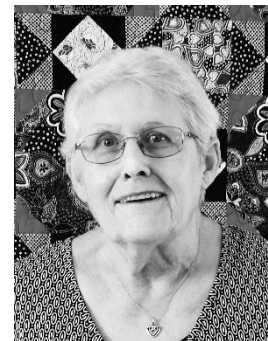

Getting to know Jacqueline Blanchenay

The featured resident for September was born in a small French town in 1939, a month after the Second World War began in Europe. She is the second oldest of eight children. She has one older sister and three younger brothers and three younger sisters. She has a charming French accent, and her name is Jacqueline Blanchenay.



Her dad was in The National Gendarmerie branch of Armed Forces and as the Germans invaded France at the beginning of the war his unit was sent to Morocco, North Africa. Her mom, an aunt, and grandma were left to care for Jacqueline and her older sister in France until 1941. In 1941 mom and the two girls were reunited with dad in Morocco. At age two, it was the first time Jacqueline had met her father. He had to deploy to Morocco a month before her birth in 1939. She was in North Africa from age two until age seven, and the war was over. Jacqueline remembers going to Catholic school in a horse drawn carriage, and the family adding two more kids to the family before moving back to France in 1946.

The family returned to Versailles, France where her father continued serving in the government as part of the “Gendarmerie Nationale” (National Police). She lived with the growing family at Camp de Satory, a base near Versailles until her early twenties. Her family chores included food shopping and doing laundry for the family. In 1958 she graduated from high school. After graduation she went to work as a secretary at a chemical company.

In 1963 Jacqueline went to England to work as an Au Pair, and to learn English. In addition to her Au Pair duties the family she lived with also wanted Jacqueline to cook “French food.” Jacqueline recalled, “I didn't know how to cook, so I had my mom send me a cookbook, and that solved the problem.” A year later she returned to France with two diplomas and speaking English.

Back in France she went to work for a Swedish flooring company, Trelleborg. The international company that provides flooring for subway cars and buses needed a secretary that spoke both English and French. She worked for them for about a year.

She left the flooring company because she had two cousins in New York and an aunt that wanted Jacqueline to go with her to visit them. Jacqueline and her aunt left Cannes, France by ship and on May 27, 1964, they sailed into New York. Jacqueline recalls, “It was before the Verrazano Bridge was finished, and everyone was out on the deck looking up at the men, working on the bridge.”

Soon after arriving in the United States Jacqueline met Rene', a friend of one of her cousins. On November 7, 1964, Jacqueline, and Rene' were married. They have two children Valerie and Marc. In January of 2001 both Jacqueline and Rene' became Naturalized United States Citizens. They remained husband and wife until his passing from cancer in March 2001.

Jacqueline has been employed nearly all her adult life as a secretary where being able to speak both English and French was essential to the job. The trend continued after her arrival in the United States. One of her early jobs in the U. S. was with a French petroleum company located at Rockefeller Center. They needed a secretary that could speak French. The job lasted about a year when the French Chamber of Commerce hired Jacqueline. The purpose of the Chamber of Commerce is to promote France and Jacqueline recalls organizing conferences where hundreds of men from all over were discussing opportunities France had to offer. She worked for the Chamber of Commerce for three years.

The family bought a home in Long Island in 1970 and lived there until 1985. In 1985 they moved to Wayne, New Jersey. Rene' went to work for Peugeot Automobiles and Jacqueline started work at Lucas Aerospace. She stayed at Lucas until 2000. She worked at Thales, Airbus from 2000 until she retired in 2005.

After retiring, in 2006 she moved to Tucson, Arizona and to the Meadows of Crystal Lake in 2021. Jacqueline's hobbies include quilting and knitting. At the Meadows she is a proofreader for the Action News.

It is \$285 for dirty roofs and \$145 for a relatively clean roof as determined by a representative from Smart Coat Painting. Once you have been advised of the price, please come to the office with your check made out to Smart Coat Painting. Write your lot number on the check.

**The cutoff date for this is September 1.

**Anyone who decides to have the roof cleaned after that date will be charged 20% additional.

Paint Committee Update

Once the Paint committee finished their inspection of each home, the Office has been busy all summer sending out over 300 fascia board replacement and excessive foliage violation letters. Yes, it is to be done before the Smart Coat Painters arrive to start preparing the houses for painting. The foliage must be at least a foot away from your house so the painters can access the walls. Also, Smart Coat will not paint virgin wood or concrete. If your fascia boards have been replaced or you have new driveway, it is your responsibility to paint the first coat. The painting is scheduled to start in October – November, weather permitting. You will be notified when your driveway and house will be prepped and painted. It is the homeowner's responsibility to have their house in good order so that the paint company can paint all the homes properly. This is a major project and, in the past, had an excellent outcome with your cooperation.
