VoiceSaver® keeps track of the total number of calls and other aggregate call counts in a binary file called "use.dat". This file resides in the folder where the VoiceSaver starts from, generally it is be the c:\pec.

Data Fields in the Use.Dat

Each field in the use.dat is 4 bytes and may have a value from 0 to 2,000,000,000. The following table describes the meaning of each data field. The utility program UseAscii generates the equivalent ASCII translation.
