Lunch Schedule & Sign-up Instructions

The Heritage Senior Center provides lunch 5 days a week, Monday through Friday, picking up a "Grab & Go" meal or eating at the Center.

"Grab & Go" meal pick up time is: 10:30am - 11:30am

Dining at the Center begins at 11:30am

- 1. BE SURE TO fill out the monthly lunch sign-up sheet and CIRCLE if you are getting a "Grab & Go" meal or eating at the Center.
- 2. **Directions for Monthly sign-up:** Sign into Copilot and TOUCH the days on the screen that you plan to eat lunch at the Center or will be picking up a "Grab & Go" meal. Be sure to select only one of them for each day you plan to eat lunch.
- 3. When you have completed with sign-up, please hand in your lunch sign-up sheet to a staff person.
- 4. If you need to make a change to your lunch sign-up sheet at a later date, please leave a note with staff AND make the change on Copilot.
- 5. **Directions for Daily Sign-in**: Each member signs into Copilot separately. Example: husband and wife. The Staff will *assist, if necessary*, but it is up to YOU to check yourself in <u>each</u> day and to also sign up for your monthly meals.
- 6. <u>Meal head counts are ordered TWO business days ahead.</u> For example, a meal ordered on Monday is ordered on Thursday, Wednesday's meal is ordered on Monday, etc.
- 7. Please pick up "Grab & Go" lunches on time, by 11:30am or call us EACH time you will be late. We will not be saving meals for you unless you let us know you will be late. Please be respectful and use exceptions sparingly.



Closure Due to Inclement Weather


When snow and or ice is predicted for the day and you would like to confirm if the Senior Center will be open please call the center at: (717) 292-7471

APRIL BOOK CLUB

Monday, April 29, 2024

The Lamplighters is a mystery, a love story and a ghost story all at once. Cornwall, 1972. Three keepers vanish from a remote lighthouse, miles from the shore. The entrance door is locked from the inside. The clocks have stopped. The Principal Keeper's weather log describes a mighty storm, but the skies have been clear all week. What happened to the three men, out on the tower? Twenty years later, the women they left behind have been driven apart by the tragedy. Still struggling to move on, Helen, Jenny and Michelle are approached by a writer who wants to know their side of the story. But by confronting the past, dark fears and hidden truths begin to surface. Inspired by real events, Emma Stonex weaves a suspenseful mystery with an unforgettable story of love and grief.
