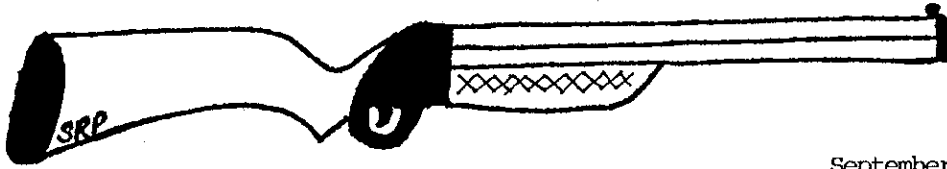
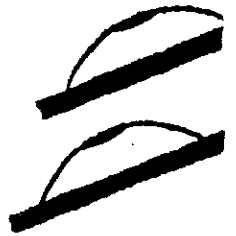

BOYD WICKMAN WINS ZONE 5

On June 2, 3, & 4th the Zone 5 Skeet Championships were held at Gateway Gun Club in St. Louis, MO. The weather was great, the shooters superb, and the turnout was a record setter.

On Friday, 76 shooters went to the line for the Doubles championship. Two shooters, Randy Borth of St. Louis and Mike Schmidt, Jr. of Wisconsin were unstoppable. Both were perfect in the tough twin event. Mike emerged as Champion after an exciting shoot-off.

Saturday morning started with the 410 event and Glenn Ernst from Springfield, MO posted the lone 98 in the first flight out. There were many 97's to follow but Glenn's 98 stood tall. Bill Buettgenbach from Lincoln, NE was AA1 after a shoot-off with Keith Anderson of St. Louis, both having shot 97. Class A was won by Bill Costello of Iowa after a heated shoot-off of 94's. Bill is one of the hardest workers on a skeet field I have ever seen, and his victories are much deserved. Class B in the 410 was won by Gateway's own Brian Murphy, who was Rookie of the Year in Missouri last year. After dumping seven targets his first round, Brian hung in to break 73 of his next 75. Way to work Brian! Class C in the 410 was won by Tom Finch from Iowa with 90x100 and C Hintermeister also from Iowa took Class D laurels with an 86x100.

Saturday afternoon saw the wind come up big time and some of the scores in the 20Ga plummeted. Mike Schmidt, Boyd Wickman, Bruce Moreland and Randy Borth all had brilliant 99's. Mike again showed off his doubles prowess and took Champ, while Boyd was Runner-up. Randy took AA1 and Bill Costello was AA2 with 98. Bruce Moreland won A1 and A2 went to C. Else from Iowa. Class B in the 20 Ga was won by Jerry Borders of Gateway with 92. A new shooter, this was his first major class win. Class C 20Ga was won by Jim McKinnon of St Louis with 97 and D Class by Dr. Jim Costin of Poplar Bluff.

On Sunday morning 116 shooters went out to shoot the 28 Ga. For some this was memorable, like Len Boblitt of Decatur, IL who broke his first 100 straight ever in the 28 Ga. Congratulations! Al Ventucci, manager of Gateway Gun Club was victorious in the shoot-offs. Class A was won by B Biggs of Iowa with 99; Class B 28 Ga was won by Len Boblitt with his 100 straight. C Class 28 Ga was won by T Sheridan of IL with a super 97 and Class D 28Ga by D Mickelson of Minnesota.

Then it was Big Gun Time. The 12 Ga event had just gotten started when a motorist hit a power pole and knocked out power in the area for 2 hours. After some re-squadding to get out-of-state shooters on the fields first so they would not be late for planes or long trips home, the 12 Ga event rolled on again. There were six 100's in the 12 Ga event with Jesse Johnson of Peoria, IL. taking Top Honors. Not only is Jesse a great referee, but also a heck of a shot. AA was won by Boyd Wickman, Class A by R Briskin, Class B by Neal Schisler of Springfield, IL. Class C by D Mickelson of Minnesota, Class D by Jeff Nichols of St. Louis and E Class by Scott Nenninger of St Louis with a hot 97.
