Her first key acting role was playing the lead role of Mezza in the telemovie ECONOMY CLASS for Ch 7; she was a Moosehead Award Melbourne International Comedy Festival show FOOTY CHICKS, a regular voice cast ensemble member for ABC 774's weekly radio serial THE BREAKFAST SHIFT and has appeared in many independent theatre and films. In the short MAGGIE-MAY, she was nominated for Best Supporting Actor at the Terror in the Bay Film Festival. Katrina can currently be seen in the online web drama INCOMING: Words of War and as the fumbling presenter in the most recent Reflex paper TVC.
