This form is the first step in requesting an investigation by the NAACP into allegations of civil rights or social justice violations that have occurred in the jurisdiction of our branch. Information shared in this report will be analyzed by members of the Legal Redress Committee to consider if and how the NAACP can help. Submitting this form is not intended to be, and should not be interpreted as a contract of any nature either stated or implied. Additionally, submitting this form does not constitute filing an official complaint with any agency or court of competent jurisdiction and does not count toward any time limits required by state or federal law for filing a civil rights complaint.

Persons age 17 and younger are not permitted to complete this form. Youth who have experienced an incident of civil rights violation or social injustice should contact an authorized adult (parent, responsible adult care provider or legal guardian) to complete and submit this form on their behalf. Personal data collected on this form will remain confidential. Upon review of your Request to Investigate statement, you will be contacted by the President or Legal Redress Chair of the Branch to schedule a time to discuss the details of your request further OR you will be notified by a Legal Redress Committee member with further instructions on how to proceed with your request.

Please understand that all requests to investigate a civil rights violation or social injustice will be given careful and urgent consideration. However, decisions for our Branch to get directly involved will be determined on the merit and scope of the request. Unfortunately, our limited resources do not permit us to respond to every request that we receive. Please expect a response time of at least 2 weeks. **Do not submit original documents**. Any documents submitted to the NAACP become part of the investigative file and will not be returned.

	1. I have submitted a Request to Investigate ("RTI") Civil Rights and Social Injustice Violations form to the Branch of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People ("NAACP") describing what I believe to be unfair acts of discrimination committed by ("Respondent").
	2. I understand that the NAACP is a private, nonprofit, voluntary organization. It is not a government agency. Filing the RTI form with the NAACP is not filing a complaint with an administrative agency or filing a law suit in a court of law. Whatever rights I have to file a complaint with an administrative agency or to file a civil lawsuit are completely unaffected by whether or not I have filed an RTI form with the NAACP.
	3. The deadline by which I must file my complaint or lawsuit is If I do not file my complaint or lawsuit by that time, I may have no right to a recovery from any potential harm I have alleged was committed by the Respondent.
	4. I have authorized the NAACP to investigate the incident described in the RTI form.
	5. I may choose to have the NAACP mediate my dispute in order to explore the possibility of settlement. If I choose to mediate my dispute and there is no settlement, the NAACP may refer me to the Maryland State Bar Association for a list of attorneys who may consider representing me in litigation against the Respondent.
	6. If the NAACP mediates my dispute with the Respondent, I am free at any time to terminate the mediation after notifying the NAACP and file my complaint with the appropriate state or federal agency or file a judicial lawsuit.
	7. I agree that if I enter into a settlement agreement, I will be required to sign a release of claims against the Respondent, and I will honor the terms of such a release of claims.
 -	8. The NAACP will receive no funds from any investigation, mediation or settlement.
	9. I will provide the NAACP with copies (not originals) of whatever documents I have to support the investigation. If I request in writing that some of the material be held in confidence, the NAACP will hold it in confidence; otherwise the NAACP

	may share it with the Respondent or with appropriate state or federal anti- discrimination agencies.
<u> </u>	10. I understand that the NAACP is not a law firm and cannot provide me with legal advice or legal representation. Although some of its members and volunteers are lawyers, they represent the NAACP and not me personally.
	11. I release and hold harmless the NAACP, its officers, directors, employees, agents from any claims or any suits or other causes of action whatsoever that I ever had or may have in the future against the NAACP upon or by reason of the NAACP's handling of my Request to Investigate, including any mediation in which I agree to participate.
