Jan Kurtz, Ad Council Chairperson, opened with prayer.

Staff Parish Relations Committee: Linda Yost, Chairperson, reported for SPRC.

- New Administrative Assistant: Melissa Cregger. Will begin on Monday, December 4. Will have church office hours Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday from 9 a.m. 2 p.m. Has prior church office experience.
- Had ZOOM meeting with Rev. Ann Laprade, District Superintendent, Laura Waltrup, Treasurer, Brenda Hess, incoming SPRC Chair, Dave Hudgins, incoming Treasurer, and myself on November 15, 2023, regarding Wesley finances. Discussed the following:
 - Paying 25% of Mission Shares (Apportionments) in 2024. Stepping up each successive year as able, financially. We are not required to pay back the Mission Shares we owe from June, 2023 – December, 2023.
 - Based on Wesley's income, it was recommended that Pastor Gary reducing his appointment at Wesley to half-time, beginning January, 2024 through June 30, 2024. He will then end his appointment with Wesley.
 - Beginning July 1, 2024 the possibility of Wesley having a part-time pastor; becoming a two-point charge; or being included in a multiple-point charge, for example, the North Carroll Cooperative Parish.
- Laura is composing a letter regarding the Mission Shares Step-Up Plan to be sent to our District Superintendent.

Questions ensued. Discussion on Mission Shares. They are based on our church expenses.

Trustees: No Report

Pew Report: Janet Martin said only 2 whole pews and 3 half pews are left. She will confer with Pastor Gary regarding a dedication in January. There have been \$15,000 in donations.

Wesley's Christmas Bazaar **report**: Cleared over \$6,000. Discussion. Had the perfect weekend and good weather.

Finance Committee: Business at hand is to approve the Budget for 2024. Laura reviewed it. We may be eligible for a tax credit for 3 quarters from 2021. Have a CPA firm reviewing this. No guarantee. Could be \$20,000. May not know until the end of 2024. Recommendation that we move forward knowing that we will not have a full-time pastor from Jan – June 2024, and not sure about a full-time pastor from July-Dec. 2024. Some folks think we need to build up a surplus.

Laura moved to approve the Recommended budget. All Ad Council members were in favor.
