REMAIN IN GOD



In the Gospel this Sunday, Jesus uses the metaphor of the vine and branches. Jesus is the vine, the Father is the grower, and we are the branches. This image brings two essential lessons that are vital in our Christian life: the need to always remain united with Jesus and the need to be pruned.

“I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, because without me, you can do nothing” (Jn 15:5).

In today’s world, some individuals believe that living without God is possible. They have their own routine: awake in the morning, eat something, go to work, watch TV in the evening, read a book, and spend hours on the internet. Life passes without any hope, and time passes before their eyes. In today’s world, we are taught that we can be self-sufficient, possess power, money, and pleasure and that this life is our sole possession. The Beatles are a classic example of this. At the height of their popularity, they said: ‘We are more famous than God!’ That was the beginning of their downfall. While some may think and act like God, observing those who are powerful and wealthy is important.

But Jesus reminds us in today’s Gospel that he is the source of real life. As the true vine and his branches, we must join Him, who provides us with the life we need.

We need pruning to bear much fruit: “My Father is the vine grower. He takes away every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and everyone that does he prunes so that it bears more fruit” (Jn 15:2). Pruning means purifying. Living the trials that life brings is not easy, but if we remain in the Lord, we will have the strength and courage to live according to the will of God. To be pruned is to receive the care we need to produce more fruits of holiness. God must eliminate things that make us feel empty and sad, like sin or our vices, which lead to a lot of darkness in our lives.

If your child missed the scheduled confession day for First Communion, please call the Parish Office to schedule an appointment as soon as possible.

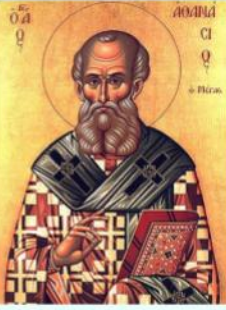

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ATHANASIUS



Athanasius led a tumultuous but dedicated life of service to the Church. He was the great champion of the faith against the widespread heresy of Arianism, the teaching by Arius that Jesus was not truly divine. The vigor of his writings earned him the title of doctor of the Church.

Born of a Christian family in Alexandria, Egypt, and given a classical education, Athanasius became secretary to Alexander, the bishop of Alexandria, entered the priesthood, and was eventually named bishop himself. His predecessor, Alexander, had been an outspoken critic of a new movement growing in the East—Arianism.

When Athanasius assumed his role as bishop of Alexandria, he continued the fight against Arianism. At first, it seemed that the battle would be easily won and that Arianism would be condemned. Such, however, did not prove to be the case. The Council of Tyre was called, and for several reasons that are still unclear, Emperor Constantine exiled Athanasius to northern Gaul. This was to be the first in a series of travels and exiles reminiscent of the life of St. Paul.

After Constantine died, his son restored Athanasius as bishop. This lasted only a year, however, for he was deposed once again by a coalition of Arian bishops. Athanasius took his case to Rome, and Pope Julius I called a synod to review the case and other related matters.

Five times, Athanasius was exiled for his defense of the doctrine of Christ's divinity. During one period, he enjoyed ten years of relative peace—reading, writing, and promoting the Christian life along the lines of the monastic ideal to which he was greatly devoted. His dogmatic and historical writings are almost all polemic, directed against every aspect of Arianism.

Among his ascetical writings, his *Life of St. Anthony* achieved astonishing popularity and significantly established monastic life throughout the Western Christian world.

Reflection: Athanasius suffered many trials while he was bishop of Alexandria. He was given the grace to remain strong against what probably seemed at times to be insurmountable opposition. Athanasius lived his office as bishop completely. He defended the true faith of his flock, regardless of the cost to himself. In today's world, we are experiencing this same call to remain true to our faith, no matter what.

PERMANECER EN DIOS



En el Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús usa la metáfora de la vid y los sarmientos. Jesús es la vid, el Padre es el cultivador y nosotros somos las ramas. Esta imagen trae dos lecciones esenciales que son vitales en nuestra vida cristiana: la necesidad de permanecer siempre unidos a Jesús y la necesidad de ser podados.

“Yo soy la vid; sois las ramas. El que permanece en mí y yo en él, dará mucho fruto, porque sin mí nada podéis hacer” (Jn 15,5).

En el mundo actual, algunas personas creen que vivir sin Dios es posible. Tienen su propia rutina: se despiertan por la mañana, comen algo, van a trabajar, miran televisión por la noche, leen un libro y pasan horas en Internet. La vida pasa sin esperanza alguna y el tiempo pasa ante sus ojos. En el mundo actual, se nos enseña que podemos ser autosuficientes, poseer poder, dinero y placer y que esta vida es nuestra única posesión. Los Beatles son un ejemplo clásico de esto. En el apogeo de su popularidad, dijeron: “¡Somos más famosos que Dios!” Ese fue el comienzo de su caída. Si bien algunos pueden pensar y actuar como Dios, es importante observar a los que son poderosos y ricos.

Pero Jesús nos recuerda en el Evangelio de hoy que él es la fuente de la vida real. Como vid verdadera y como sus ramas, debemos unirnos a Él, quien nos proporciona la vida que necesitamos.

Necesitamos poda para dar mucho fruto: “Mi Padre es el viñador. Todo sarmiento que en mí no da fruto, lo quita y todo el que sí lo hace, lo poda para que dé más fruto” (Jn 15,2). Podar significa purificar. Vivir los caminos que trae la vida no es fácil, pero si permanecemos en el Señor, tendremos la fuerza y el coraje para vivir según la voluntad de Dios. Ser podado es recibir los cuidados necesarios para producir más frutos de santidad. Dios debe eliminar las cosas que nos hacen sentir vacíos y tristes, como el pecado o nuestros vicios, que provocan mucha oscuridad en nuestras vidas.
