Fieldstone Show Circuit Rules and Guidelines

- Entries: Please submit entries via email to Candice Reece at Candice.Upchurch@yahoo.com. Please be sure to include Horse Name and USHJA Number, Owner & Rider Name and USHJA Numbers, Classes Entering, and Stabling Information, including tack stalls and shavings orders. You MUST have horse and rider USHJA numbers on entry form in order to get USHJA points. Entries are due by **Wednesday, April 3rd**. A \$25 late fee may be applied on entries received later than ~~April 3rd~~ at 7:00PM. Stall requests received after 7:00 PM on Wednesday, August 3rd are subject to a stall increase of \$25 per stall.
- Class Fees: All Classes \$20 Stall Fee: \$100 Shavings: Included with stall fee
- Fees: Each horse/rider combination will be charged an EMT fee of \$5 per day. An EMT will be on grounds during posted schooling and show times. A \$15 office fee will be charged per horse/rider combination. An open check fee of \$15 will be charged for all accounts not closed at the show. Non-members of USHJA Outreach will be charged a \$5 non member fee. USHJA Outreach memberships are FREE and can be signed up for at the show or online at <https://www.ushja.org/competition/outreach>.
- Coggins: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a Copy of the Original Coggins test which may be emailed with entries or presented to the show office upon arrival. Stalls: Stalls are 12'x12' permanent box stalls and will be available noon Friday through Sunday. A \$35 grounds fee will be charged for any horse not competing. No outside shavings are allowed.
- Arenas: 1 Arena is 150'x 250' and the second arena is 100' x 225' the third arena is 100'x 150', all weather sand footing. Schooling: There will be open schooling Friday from 2:00pm until 5:30 pm. Open schooling will be available Saturday & Sunday mornings from 6:30am until times stated on schedule. There will be 15 minutes schooling breaks between fence heights of time allows. No jumper or Derby schooling.
- Divisions Eligibility : Junior divisions- Riders that are 17 years old and younger. Adult Amateur Divisions- Riders 17 years and older that are NOT equine professionals. Open Divisions- Open to ALL riders including Professionals.
- Cross Entries: A horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. Walk Trot Poles may only cross enter in Open Walk Trot Cross rails.
- Awards: All classes will receive ribbons First through Sixth unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & Prize and a Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.
- Attire: Proper show attire is required. Polo shirts with collars are allowed at shows June-August. No chaps allowed. Helmets: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.
- Dogs: NO OUTSIDE DOGS ALLOWED
- Concessions: Will not be available during show hours. You can also Door Dash lots of different choices available in Mansfield.
- Split Classes: All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split.
- Management reserves the right to combine or scratch classes/divisions.
- Fieldstone Show Circuit may use the USEF rulebook for any issues that arise.

I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm"). I AGREE to hold harmless and release the USHJA and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the USHJA or the Competition. I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the USHJA or the Competition. I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the USHJA and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition.
