State Rep's Report

Jimmy Les reported there was no state meeting this month. There is a bylaw change for us to vote on for the next state meeting in August.

Proposed bylaw change:

1. Any person accepting a nomination for an Executive Board and Board of Directors position for ABATE of Florida, Inc. or any of its chapters will furnish proof of a valid motor vehicle operator's license and a valid motorcycle endorsement before the next Delegates or Chapter Meeting. This will be accomplished by submitting a photocopy of their driver's license and a current copy of an online drivers license check at: <https://www6.hsmv.state.fl.us/DLCheck/main.jsp> Failing to comply with this amendment or the lack of a valid drivers license or motorcycle endorsement will render any nominee ineligible to hold office at the state or chapter level. EXCEPTION: Any person who does not operate a motorcycle or a motor vehicle would be exempt from this clause.

2. The president of ABATE of Florida, Inc., after verifying that any State or Chapter member of a Board of Directors who operates a motorcycle or motor vehicle does not have a valid driver's license and motorcycle endorsement may, at his discretion, remove that party from their elected or appointed position.

.After a lengthy discussion a motion was made to reject this by-law proposal. Seconded. All in favor 40 opposed 4. Motion passed. Our delegates will be instructed to vote against this by-law change at the next state meeting on behalf of our chapter.

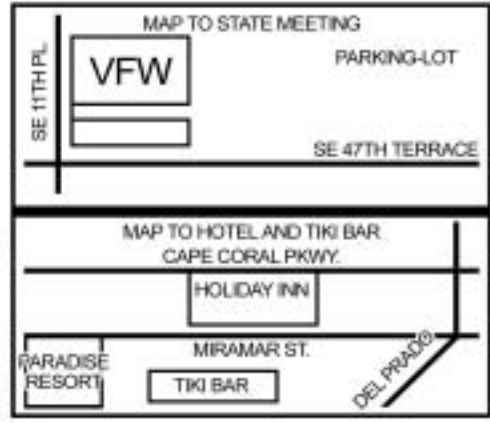

Old Hippy's Corner

The Legislation season this year has not been exactly what I had hoped it would be.

Granted there were no laws that came out that inhibited the freedom that we so much try to keep, but on the other hand there has been a lack of getting proposed bill that I feel is of great importance for the safety of all us that use the roads., Whether we are on 2,3,4 or even 18 wheels these proposed bills that dealt with the cell phone usage and the enhanced penalties for “right away infringement” accidents that cause injuries to death are have been more effective way to saves lives than all the mandatory helmet law talks that have been going around lately.

Case it points on cell phone usage: I had a close encounter with a mini van the other day when this “A” hole was too busy talking to check his mirror when changing lanes and even after I laid on the horn, he still didn’t look . I was lucky that day because there was nobody in the lane next to me.

You see, hear and read about it all the time. The “Driver” was talking on the cell phone or texting somebody which caused the accident by being distracted from what should be happening, like paying attention to road and drive, like the bus driver that was caught on camera texting and running into a back of another vehicle.

Face it the cagers already have a lot of distraction at there finger tips like stereo and AC controls to play with, but with advancement of technology, they now have more things ,and some of them at more intense, that they can do instead of paying attention., like trying to text while driving! Some states even the passenger can not use a cell phone without hands free equipment.

Not paying attention by doing other things while driving is by far the largest contributor toward accidents and is some cases it amazes me what people try to do while behind the wheel. Take the example in Chicago: A motorcyclist was killed after being struck by a car driven by a woman who was painting her fingernails at the time of the crash. [Anita Zaffke](#), 54, was wearing a helmet and wearing a bright yellow biker’s jacket, when she was hit from behind by a [Chevy Impala at a stop light](#). [Zaffke was thrown “a couple of hundred feet” by the impact](#). The driver of the Impala, Lora Hunt, 48, told police she was painting her fingernails as she approached the red light at that corner, and she apparently didn’t see the motorcycle. Enough said about helmet saving you and bright colors makes it easier for them to see you!! Didn’t help, this time! At least there will be charges against the woman in the very near future instead of a traffic ticket for running a red light. (enhanced punishment)

Note other states already have laws regarding cell/text use and enhanced punishment for “right away” infringements, but once again Florida lags behind when it is needed. Maybe the persons who we elected are too busy using their Blackberry’s and Iphones in their cages to want to give them up! I know we all hate laws that tend to tell us what we can and can not do, but there are laws out there that we need to have in order to save us from each other.

We need not to give up, but start now on making sure these types of bills are reintroduced and signed into law in the next session by contacting our legislators early to help this along.

When you out riding look around and see just how many people are driving, moving their arm around with a phone to their ear, Scary it’s it?

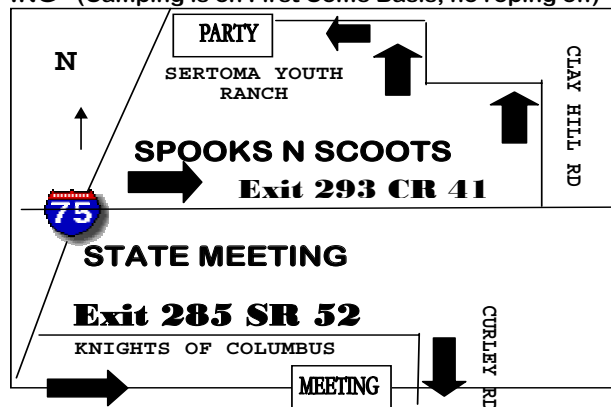

then west 1/8 mile*
