Policy:

The Obedience Club of San Diego County will pay for the initial certification and each subsequent renewal, as the need for additional evaluators are deemed necessary.

- Current evaluators will be reimbursed \$100 for past costs and any future renewal costs will be reimbursed as per the current AKC fee.
- New evaluators will be reimbursed for the initial cost of certification as well as renewal costs as per the current AKC fee.
- This policy covers reimbursement for CGC evaluators, ATT evaluators and Fit Dog Instructors.

CGC Coordinator Responsibilities:

- 1. Determining when the club has a need for additional evaluators.
- 2. Nominating individuals to be added as evaluators for the club.
- 3. Confirming that the newly identified individuals meet the Club's requirements to become certified.
- 4. Working with the evaluators and OCSDC treasurer to obtain the proper paperwork and to keep certification on file.

Applicant Responsibilities:

- 1. Individuals will be responsible for completing the AKC requirements for each certification.
- 2. Individuals will be responsible for submitting the applications to the AKC.
- 3. Individuals must be an active trainer for the club. In order to be considered an active trainer, the individual must have taught or co-taught a class, including Drop-in, with the club within the last year.
- 4. Once certified, individuals will be required to participate in at least two evaluations for the club per calendar year.
- 5. Submit for reimbursement using the club's reimbursement jotform.

- 6. The evaluators will understand that reimbursement is contingent on the needs of the club.
- 7. The evaluators understand that if the above requirements are not met, reimbursement for renewal may not be approved.
- 8. Evaluators who have been reimbursed for their certification may not charge the club or club members for their services
