

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

ENTRIES RECEIVED BEFORE OPENING DATE WILL BE RETURNED!

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, or fax. No hand deliveries allowed. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Lori Brison at loribscentwork@gmail.com No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. However, the club reserves the right to alter this policy due to current events. If the trial is cancelled due to public guidelines, you will receive a full refund.

Dogs withdrawn after closing because of injury or other medical condition are eligible for a 50% refund. Owner must provide a note from their veterinarian no later than 24 hours before each trial starts.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day.

MOVE-UP INFORMATION

All pre-trial move-ups must be received by 5pm PT, Monday, November 27, 2023. The AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. Please send an email to loribscentwork@gmail.com to request your move-up. Day to day move-ups will be allowed provided the trial secretary receives your move-up form within 15 minutes after the last class concludes on Saturday.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

The Obedience Club of San Diego County, Inc. is offering a maximum of 30 entries to be placed on a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after the closing date unless it is replaced by a waitlisted entry. Only then will a full refund be issued for the withdrawn entry. All checks for waitlisted entries that do not move off the list into the trial will be shredded.

New Overall Title Rosettes and Element Title Flats will be offered at these trials.

<u>High in Trial</u>

Novice, Advanced, Excellent and Master High in Trial Rosettes will be offered at this trial.

Only teams who participate and qualify, in the same difficulty level of all elements offered for that level (Container, Interior, Exterior, and Buried) are eligible for High in Trial. There is no separate High in Trial for the Novice A and Novice B sections; they are combined. HIT is determined by adding the team's faults across the elements. If there is a tie based on faults, then the team's times will be summed, and the faster finishing team will win.

CONDITIONS AND SEARCH AREAS

Search areas may be of any shape, and size specified in the Regulations for each class. Searches may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, asphalt, and on uneven surfaces. Trial will take place rain or shine.

SITE INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting area.

The Handler's Briefing will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there is an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing. The handler briefing may be modified due to current AKC Guidelines/Best Practices.

Warm-up area. The club shall designate a warm-up area. One labelled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. Clubs may also place blank containers.

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5, Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

Spectators are usually encouraged at scent work trials but may be limited or not allowed at all due to current events. Spectating is at the judge's discretion.

Exhibitors and spectators are forbidden to discuss **any details** of the search with **ANYONE**.

Crating: You will be crating from your car, or you may set up canopies in the parking lot. There is no shade so please bring your own. Canopies will need weights. Please respect others – **absolutely no idling of cars!** OCSDC will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. No overnight setups. There will be no overnight security.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Obedience Club of San Diego County, Inc and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Obedience Club of San Diego County, Inc reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Obedience Club of San Diego County, Inc or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

It is NOT appropriate to scout or contact anyone at the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments, and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

These trials will be run one level at a time. Be prepared to run all elements of the same level back-to-back. Other trial specifics will be determined after closing.

OCSDC will be following all current state/local/AKC/site specific guidelines to bring you a fun and safe trial.

Please pay attention to my opening dates! If your entry goes in the mail more than two mailing days prior to my opening date, it is guaranteed to be too early! No earlier than Fri, Oct 27!

RV day parking is available at this site. No overnight parking will be allowed. Please see camping info below.

A preliminary confirmation will be sent once your entry is received. A final confirmation with trial details will be sent out about one week before the trial.

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Entering Novice A or B: The Novice A class is for **beginner dogs**. The Novice B class is for dogs who have earned a title in that element (in AKC or in another organization), for Scent Work Judges, and handlers who have worked as professional detection dog handlers. The exhibitor is responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es). Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of qualifying scores.

NOTE: Dogs may enter up to two different difficulty levels of each element at the same trial, as long as they are eligible to enter each level. <u>Examples:</u> Dogs may enter Novice B Container <u>and</u> Advanced Container – they must have earned the Novice Container Title. Dogs may enter Advanced Exterior <u>and</u> Excellent Exterior – they must have earned the Advanced Exterior Title.
