VIJAY ANAND** secured an awe-inspiring score of 86.67% marks and the school rewarded him with **4-gram Gold coin**, followed by **S. NIRANJANASRI** securing second position with (85.33%) and the school rewarded her with **3 gram of Gold coin** and **R. ISHWARYA** getting the third position with 78.5% marks and the school rewarded her with **2000 rupees of cash prize**.
