GFWC is international in scope, with over 100,000 members in more than a dozen countries, united through the common purpose of community service.

The California Federation of Women's Clubs (CFWC) is divided into 21 districts with a membership of more than 12,400 in 267 clubs. Their objective is to unite the influence and enterprise of California members to carry on the clubs' projects of education, moral, social welfare and civic interests.

Because we are so diversified, there is an area of interest for almost everyone. Our International, State and District levels offer the member leadership training, current information on vital issues of the day, and an opportunity for developing our talents to the fullest.

THE WOMAN'S CLUB OF HERMOSA BEACH was founded in 1921 and became affiliated with the General Federation of Women's Clubs in 1923.

A Southern California Clubwoman, Dr. June McCarroll, initiated the white center lines on highways.

Established 75% of America's Public Libraries.

Established the first Kindergartens, Day Care Centers, and Teacher's Retirement.

Supported equal pay for equal work.

Started an Alcohol and Drug Abuse Education Program for women and vouth.

Worked for passage of the Pure Food and Drugs Act (1906) Supported the first child labor laws.

Opened the GFWC Women's History and Resource Center in Washington, D.C.

IN CALIFORNIA

Proposed legislation for a Juvenile Court for California. Passed into law.

Placed the bells along the El Camino Real.
