Nailsea Tithe Barn is a stunning 15th century wedding venue licensed for civil marriage ceremonies nestled in the quiet west end of Nailsea. The Barn is situated in a picturesque village with the stunning Holy Trinity Church just behind, with Clevedon, Portishead and Bristol only a short drive away.

The Barn has two main rooms, the Tithe Hall and the Hannah More Room. Both rooms have many unique features that add to the Barn's overall charming appearance such as huge beautiful vaulted ceilings and exposed timber frames, soft grey stone and hidden owl holes. The Barn is most definitely full of romance and character.

With capacity for up to 150 people, couples have exclusive hire of the Barn from 12 noon Friday until 12 noon Sunday with the ability to tailor the venue as you wish

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

CAN WE HAVE OUR CEREMONY AT THE BARN?

The Barn is licensed for weddings therefore you are able to have your ceremony at the barn however you will need to contact the Somerset Registrar to make the arrangements for this and you would be responsible for their additional fees.

DOES THE TITHE BARN HAVE AN ALCOHOL LICENCE?

The Tithe Barn holds an alcohol licence and alcohol can be served until 11 pm. There is a small charge for the Bar of £60 to be made directly to the Cocktails & Bars.

WHAT FACILITIES ARE AVAILABLE?

A small but modern kitchen is available, equipped with fridge, dishwasher, six ring stove, microwave and plate warming cabinet. There are modern toilets which include fully accessible toilets and baby changing facilities. The building is fully accessible with disabled parking, access ramps and a hearing induction loop.

DO I HAVE TO USE SUPPLIERS APPROVED BY THE BARN?

We can provide you with a list of local suppliers which you may find helpful but you are free to choose your own.

CAN WE DECORATE THE BARN?

The possibilities are endless when it comes to personalisation at the Barn however because of the age of the building, you are not permitted to attach anything to the walls or floor. Similarly, lighted candles are not allowed because of the risk of fire however you are welcome to use battery candles. Floral decorations, balloons and custom lighting are all permitted.

CAN WE HAVE MUSIC?

The Tithe Barn holds an entertainments licence which allows for live performances. Live music is encouraged allowing you to choose from harpists and pianists to acoustic singers and everything in between however we are in close proximity of our neighbours so music with a heavy bass such as amplified disco or rock style music is not permitted. A DJ is also a great option and is permitted at the Barn. We do have a sound limiter set at 93 decibels.

HOW LONG DO WE HAVE THE BARN FOR?

The hire cost of the Barn allows for access from midday Friday to midday Sunday. This enables you to set up for your wedding on Friday afternoon so that you are free to enjoy your day Saturday, not worrying about any clearing up until Sunday.
