Admission Requirements

- Fully complete registration form packet.
- Pay the non-refundable, non-transferable registration fee per child
- Attend mandatory orientation Saturday August 5th (**10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.**)
- Meet with the financial administrator and sign a financial contract.

Operations - 2023/2024 School year

- Fall program: August 14th - May 24, 2024
- Summer 2024 program - June 26th - July 28th

Days of operation:

- Monday – Friday 8:00 - 4:00

Center Opening / Closing Hours: 7:30am - 7:00pm

Arrival and Dismissal Hours: 8:00 am - 4:00pm

Aftercare - Monday - Friday 4:00 - 5:30 p.m. (Based on enrollment)

Early drop off 7:45 a.m.

Doors Lock at 9:00 a.m. Sharp!

- **Early pick-up: 3:30 p.m.**

Please Note:

- All doors automatically **lock at 9:00 am sharp** and there is no late admittance without an approved excuse.
- Schedule your doctor's appointment etc. carefully.
- All children not picked up by 4:05 will be automatically taken to aftercare and a daily drop-off fee of \$25.00 will be assessed.

Tuition and Fees:

It is our ardent desire to give those families who are financially constrained, an opportunity to enroll their children and partake in the Hajja's House experience. We have created a two-tiered honor system for the 2023/2024 school year. In addition you may apply for **financial assistance through the CAPS program.**

We ask that you consider your financial situation and choose honestly and wisely. Thank you!

Please note the following tuition rates and payment changes and plan accordingly:

Hagar's Preschool full time

Tier 1: \$925.00 monthly (\$9,225.00 annually)

Tier 2: \$875.00 monthly (\$8,750.00 annually)

Ishmael Nursery/ZZ's Friends Only / (Part time):

\$6,800.00 (*Yearly Tuition at \$85 per day / 2 days only*)

Please note children who are completely toilet trained can take advantage of the Hagar's preschool rate

Tier 1: \$950.00 monthly (\$9,500.00 annually)

Tier 2: 900.00 monthly (\$9000.00 annually)

After School program fees :

Yearly Registration fee - \$100.00

- \$85.00 per week (to be paid monthly \$340.00) or (bi-Weekly \$170.00)
- Daily drop - In (\$25.00)

Yearly Tuition paid in full receive a 7% discount

15% of yearly tuition due August 1, 2024. (the balance will be divided into 9 monthly payments)

Tuition payments are due between the 1st through the 5th of each month after the 5th you will be subject to a \$75.00 late fee.

All fees are due by Thursday, June 1st -Thurs. 15th for returning families and July 1st for new families and ends when slots are filled. Slots are filled on a first come basis.

Discipline Policy:

Classroom management is at the heart of our disciplinary policies.

Part of a child's development involves learning social rules. It is our job as responsible adults to provide guidance, love and support as our little ones become more aware of their surroundings and emotions.

We are reminded about the importance of good character from this saying of the Prophet:

When asked about the best of the believers, the Prophet replied, "They are those who have the best character and manners."

At Hajja's House we will use **10 plus 1** techniques designed to help raise well-behaved children.

1. Stop the action
2. Look for the positive intent
3. Educate
4. Set clear verbal limits
5. Set physical limits
6. Provide choices
7. Natural consequences
8. Use active listening and the "sports casting" technique

9. Time-out techniques
10. Redirecting the action

Plus One - Parent Education

Health wellness, Immunizations, Emergency Care.

- All children are required to have the age appropriate immunization record on file or a signed affidavit against such immunizations within **30 days of child's enrollment.**

More details of our wellness program will be outlined in the parent handbook, which will be available at orientation.

Class size and ratios

At Hajja's House, maintaining our ratios is important.

Ratios allow for proper care, safety and quality, daily instruction.

We are an institution that goes beyond the standard rules / regulations as it relates to the proper care of our children.

Therefore, every classroom will have an assistant during the most critical times of care.

We have 3 classes:

1. Ishmael's Lambs: Nursery - Infants 6 months -18 months [1:6]
2. ZZ's Friends (young two's and 3's) 2-3 [Potty Training Class] [1:7]
3. Hagar's Children: Preschool / Kindergarten:3, 4 and 5 [1:12]
