* **Canyonlands National Park** is cut into three land districts by the Green and Colorado rivers. Island in the Sky, in the north of the park, is about 40 minutes from Moab, UT via UT 313. The Needles district is in the southeast corner of Canyonlands, about 90 minutes from Moab or an hour from Monticello, UT via UT 211. The Maze district, in the west of the park, is the most remote and challenging; its ranger station is down 46 miles of dirt road from UT 24. All roads in The Maze require high-clearance 4WD. NPS.gov

** **Kenai Fjords National Park** is located just outside the town of Seward in south-central Alaska, 126 miles south of Anchorage. Even though the park is often inaccessible during the winter months, Seward is accessible year-round via the Seward Highway, a National Scenic Byway. Follow the Seward Highway (AK-1) south from Anchorage. It will become AK-9 around mile 35 (87 miles from Anchorage) with AK-1 heading to Homer and Kenai. Continue on AK-9 to Seward.

*** **Lake Clark National Park** and Preserve is located on the Alaska Peninsula southwest of Anchorage and west of Homer. We are not on the road system. The address provided below is for the park's field office in Port Alsworth, AK.

**** **Wrangell-St. Elias National Park** services and facilities are separated by as much as 260 miles! Some are located outside of the park boundaries. Others are located along one of the only two roads, both unpaved, that enter the park. The following webpage will help you find them all!

***** **Yosemite National Park** You can drive to Yosemite year-round and enter via Highways 41, 140, and 120 from the west. Tioga Pass Entrance (via Highway 120 from the east) is closed from approximately November through late May or June. Hetch Hetchy is open all year but may close intermittently due to snow. Please note that GPS units do not always provide accurate directions to or within Yosemite.

Adult (16+) National Parks Annual Pass (2022) \$80. The pass is good for 12 months. Each Annual Pass admits pass owner and passengers in a non-commercial vehicle. If you travel with (2) vehicles, each vehicle will need an adult with a pass.

Annual Senior (62+) Pass is \$20. Lifetime Senior Pass is \$80
