Always prepare all you do to be acceptable to the Lord: worship, sacrifice, dedication. Remind that opens gates of blessing.

#### Availability

The LORD said to my Lord: "Sit at My right hand until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet." The LORD extends Your mighty scepter from Zion: "Rule amid Your enemies." Your people shall be willing on Your day of battle. Arrayed in holy splendor, from the womb of the dawn to You belongs the dew of Your youth. (Psalms 110:1-3)

If you love Me, you will keep My commandments. And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Advocate to be with you forever—the Spirit of truth. The world cannot receive Him because it neither sees Him nor knows Him. But you do know Him, for He abides with you and will be in you (John 14:15-17)

Join me in suffering, like a good soldier of Christ Jesus. A soldier refrains from entangling himself in civilian affairs to please the one who enlisted him. Likewise, a competitor does not receive the crown unless he competes according to the rules. The

hardworking farmer should be the first to partake of the crops. Consider what I am saying, for the Lord will give you insight into all things. (2 Timothy 2:3-7)

Remind that He is always available to you when you seek and come to Him in FAITH: help, guide, protect, provide, counsel, direct, and answer.
