<u>Ground Zero –</u>

Discussed difficulties with the lawn company, and their continued commitment to improved. Please give feedback to the board for any issues you notice. We got one additional quote this past year, but it was about 4x as much as Ground Zero. We will pursue other quotes next year.

<u>HMS –</u>

We know the company had an error in billing and sent late notices, they report it was due to computer issue. There are other issues in recent months, 2 of our board members will be meeting with their leadership to discuss the issues we have had. They have filed 3 liens and collected on 2 of 3. The third we won and await payment.

Exciting News -

City of Wichita may be putting in a sidewalk from out entrance all the way to 29th Street and may consider planting some trees on our easement along 119th. We will ensure that the neighborhood doesn't have to pay specials to put in a sidewalk, need to follow up.
