Roaring Fork Recovery Support Center dba The Meeting Place was created in 2010 and incorporated as a nonprofit in 2015. Created to provide a safe and supportive place for recovery, TMP is the only organization of its kind in the Roaring Fork Valley, exclusively dedicated to providing consistent and by-donation space for recovery meetings.

Dear Supporters,

We are delighted to report that The Meeting Place (TMP) is thriving! In addition to hosting inperson meetings, TMP provides recovery support services, a virtual home for online meetings, and a wellness hub for mindfulness, yoga, and resources to benefit people in recovery in the Roaring Fork Valley and beyond.

In 2023, The Meeting Place:

- Renewed the lease for five years, maintaining our cozy space until 2029
- Completed our seventh consecutive net positive fiscal year
- Renovated the space with **brand-new carpet**, giving TMP a modern look and feel
- Hosted 25 in-person recovery meetings each week, including 12-step meetings and other fellowships, Mindfulness in Recovery, SMART, and meditation meetings
- Provided Free Childcare for the largest meeting at TMP
- Launched two free weekly Yoga for People in Recovery classes facilitated by certified yoga instructors
- Received Licensure by the State of Colorado to participate in the Opiate Antagonist Fund, allowing us to distribute free naloxone to our community
- Launched a Little Free RECOVERY Library stocked with free addiction and recovery literature

This year is off to an energetic beginning with the introduction of our new **Executive Director, Karlynn Fulmer**. She is active in the recovery community, understanding the intricacies of addiction and the importance of fellowship. Karl has worked with other non-profits and the Roaring Fork School District.

The Meeting Place envisions the implementation of the following future initiatives:

- Recovery events and wellness workshops to increase engagement and promote fellowship
- Collaboration with local non-profits sharing a similar mission
- Outdoor fellowship area, including picnic tables and garden
- Introduction of Spanish-speaking meetings
- Offering childcare for more well-attended meetings


The success of The Meeting Place is a true reflection of our community recognizing the gravity of addiction and the importance of recovery. Thank you for your generosity!
