Events and Parties

Planning a birthday party, retreat, family gathering or retreat, baby shower, private soiree or another event? Little Green Acres has a variety of customizable options, and we'd love to partner with you! We have both our craft studio that seats up to 25, and our 800sq.ft event tent that seats 80-90 people and can be heated in cooler months.

Birthday options include crafting (kids should be a minimum of 3-yrs-old to craft), planting seeds or flowers, the petting zoo, and farm visits. Typically, birthday parties last 2 hours with younger participants spending an hour crafting, planting, or doing another activity, half an hour in the petting zoo, and the rest of the time playing games, opening presents and eating. Older participants generally spend more time crafting, but we work with you to create the perfect event.

Pricing is \$150 minimum, or \$10 per participant plus the cost of materials for any craft you select as an activity (generally does not exceed \$5/per person). We have acres of parking.

The farm is open for parties and events whenever classes are not scheduled.
