What can people expect in this class?

It's a bit more structured. In First Step, we build the scaffold, in the second class, we try to fill in the scaffolding. It gives (the students) an opportunity to use a bit of variation in their playing.



What makes the ukulele different?

Its ease of playing. It's smaller, it has nylon strings and you get three sizes of ukulele that will fit your hands: the soprano, concert and tenor. It's not easy, but easier than the guitar.



What do you enjoy about teaching?

I like to see their progress and see them enjoy themselves. I like to help people learn and move on to something they really want to do, that they're motivated about. The ukulele keeps your hands and mind moving.
