She is a veteran performer of the Teen Summer Theater herself as well as having been its Musical Director for the productions of Annie, The Robber Bridegroom, and Peter Pan. A recipient of the Port Singers Scholarship in 1980, Sandy earned her Bachelor of Music Degree from SUNY Potsdam and is currently pursuing her Master's Degree at Columbia University. WHO'S WHO--CONTINUED

KENDALL C. WALSH (PRODUCER), a 1980 Schreiber graduate, already has many high school and Play Troupe productions to his credit as he takes his first crack at producing with BARNUM. After attending the U.S. Air Force Academy, he received his Bachelor's degree in Computer Science from the Rochester Institute of Technology and is currently a computer systems manager for a Wall Street consulting firm. His greatest success to date of course is the EL NEATO corporate empire, whose beginnings can be traced back to his involvement with the Teen Summer Theatre and Port Summer Show.

THE PORT SUMMER SHOW--In 1972, the Teen Summer Theatre was created by two highly dedicated and talented community residents: Pam and Ron Meadows. The Meadows gave unstintingly of their time, efforts and talents to enable the youth of the Port Washington to develop their own skills and talents and create quality theatre productions, thereby enriching the entire community. Every summer, approximately 100 teen-agers were involved in every aspect of theatre production. In fact, the Teen Summer Theatre was one of the only community activities available to teens during the summer months. Many of the teens participated in the program for a number of years and are still involved in theatrical pursuits as college students and beyond. Last summer, after fifteen years of highly-acclaimed productions, Pam and Ron announced that they could no longer devote the necessary amount of time to the program and that the Teen Summer Theatre as we knew it would have its final production.

When it became clear that the Teen Summer Theatre might no longer be an option available to their children during the summer, a group of parents and representatives of local organizations met to discuss ways to insure the continuation of this program. With the help of educational, philanthropic, and business institutions in the community, the Port Summer Show was founded to carry on the worthwhile project for both the teen-age performers and audiences of all ages to enjoy for years to come.

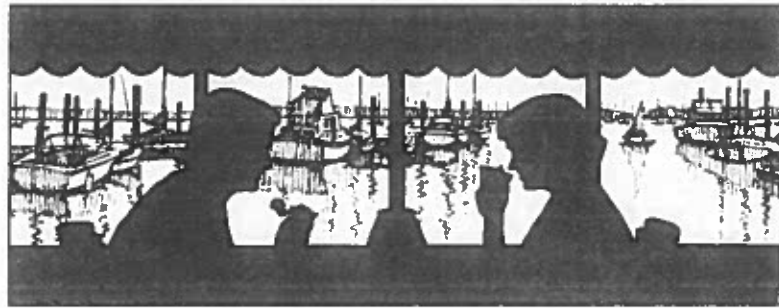
