

# School Board Accepts Donations

The Port Washington Board of Education met on July 10 for its annual reorganization meeting where newly elected board members Nora Johnson, Larry Greenstein and Elizabeth Weisburd were sworn to oaths of office and Karen Sloan was reinstated as president, while Johnson was reinstated as vice president.

After the reorganization meeting, the board held its regular meeting during which Sloan and Superintendent of Schools Dr. Kathleen Mooney explained that while it may seem quiet for the summer, the board is preparing for the upcoming year with bond work going on at both Manorhaven and Guggenheim Elementary Schools.

"We are working very diligently this summer," explained Mooney. "In terms of bond work, there is a tremendous amount of bond work going on in Manorhaven and Guggenheim; the extensions are really moving

along this summer. They're not going to be ready for September, but they're definitely making some progress and lots of staff are busy with professional development."

The board accepted donations of \$200 to be applied to the Mr. Boyle Scholarship and \$400 to be applied to the Cecilia Escamilla Memorial Scholarship, both to be awarded to graduating senior students. Also accepted was a donation of a grant in the amount of \$2,800 from Port Washington SEPTA to be applied to speech and language therapy services as push-in services in an after-school club offered in Weber Middle School, \$13,709.86 from the Weber HSA to be applied to 11 different projects that align with district and building goals—including character education, STEAM media, science supplies and literacy education—and the second payment in the amount of \$41,159.15 from the Ed Foundation to be applied to the total approved 2017-2018 Ed Foundation grants.
