RULES AND CONSTITUTION

1 Name and Objectives

The club shall be called 'Manners4Paws' and its objective will be the training of puppies and dogs basic obedience and training of pedigree dogs, ringcraft for the show ring.

2 Management Committee

The club shall be run by a Management Committee of 2 people. The Club shall be run as an Unincorporated Association – Not For Profit.

3 Club Property

Property of the Club shall be the responsibility of the Management Committee. If the Club shall cease to exist, a General Meeting shall be called to decide on the disposal of the Club's assets.

4 Club Accounts

The Club's accounts shall be held at a Bank or Building Society of the Club's choice into which all revenue of the Club shall be paid. The Management Committee will have access to this account and may use it for Club related expenses.

5 Members

Contact information will be required from all members and collected under GDPR. Membership to the club is compulsory to be covered under the Clubs insurance. Training and Course fees shall be proposed by the Management committee and ratified at the AGM. The fees will be adopted immediately.

6 AGM

The AGM will be held every December and all members will be invited to attend 1 month in advance, via social media and email.

7a Expulsion of Members

If the conduct of any member shall be injurious or likely to be injurious to the character or interest of the Club, we may propose a resolution to expel him/her.

7b Exclusion of Dogs

In fairness for all members and their dogs, no member shall attend a training class, with a dog that is unwell or is suffering from any infectious or contagious disease. If members present at a training class, a dog appears unwell or of savage disposition they may, in the interest of other dogs present, either refuse admission or request the Member to remove the dog. In fairness for all members and their dogs, no bitch in season can be accepted for training.
