- **Parish Pastoral Council information on website**: The names of pastoral council members and a link to send the Pastoral Parish Council a message will be made available on the parish website. Updates from the Parish Pastoral Council Meetings will also be made available on the website.
- **Painting of St. Michael's Church**: It is hoped that St. Michael's will be painted in May 2024.
- **Confirmation Programme**: Training for leaders of the confirmation programme will take place next Tuesday 30th January. The confirmation programme will run for the following 5 weeks from 8-9pm. Confirmation Day is March 9th.
- **First Holy Communion Programme**: The next Children's Mass will take place on 4th February. The final training night for the parents of the First Holy Communion Programme is planned for 28th February at 8pm.
- Letter Received from the Pastoral Leadership Team: Some of the main points from this letter included the following:
- *Lay Involvement in Funeral and Baptismal Ministries*: Teams of Lay People will be asked to take part in and be trained in funeral and baptismal ministries.
- *Liturgy for Engaged Couples and those celebrating significant wedding anniversaries:* Bishop Paul will lead a liturgy of blessing for engaged couples and those celebrating significant anniversaries (10, 20, 25, 40 and 50 years) in the Cathedral on Sunday, February 18th at 4.00pm. All are welcome.
- Youth Ministry: Lourdes: A Pilgrimage to Lourdes will take place from 18th-23rd July. It is requested that 2 young people (age 18-30) from our Cluster are selected to go on the pilgrimage. Youth Day 2024: A Croagh Patrick Climb with the youth of our diocese will take place on Sunday 9th June at 3pm. Pope John Paul II Awards: An Award Ceremony will take place in the Cathedral on Monday 19th February. 43 young people from across our Diocese will be receiving awards for their work in parishes over the past year– there will be 3 students from St. Josephs Secondary School in Foxford receiving awards.
