Suggestions for sharing the courts if others are waiting to play pickleball

We have 2 courts of pickleball, allowing up to 8 players at a time.

If others are waiting, you have the right to stay on your pickleball court until the top of the hour, when you need to get off so others can get on.

BUT there's feed-in play...

You may have more fun by including the waiting players, & you get to play with & against several players. For example:

- 1. When the game ends, the winning pair stays on the court but splits up, & the 2 new players each pair up with a winner.
- The sequence continues when that game finishes: the 2 winners split up & 2 new players join.

AND...

You may find that the available players fall into 2 groups: power players & finesse players, & you may want to make 1 court for each type.

- 1. Power players experienced, really fast paced, lots of slams & action
- 2. Finesse players prefer 'dinking' & slicing the ball, less slamming, or newer to game

FINALLY...

Don't be shy – you can ask the players on the other pickleball court if they'd like to mix it up & play between both courts.

One of the reasons pickleball is so popular is that it's a very social sport – you're physically close to your partner & opponents, & you're chatting with others as you wait your turn!
