FRUIT: Autumn paints the small persistent fruit a bright orange-red. 1/2" in diameter relished by birds after softened by freezing.

LEAF COLOR: Leathery dark green leaves. The foliage is highly tolerant to cedar apple rust, apple scab, and powdery mildew.

HABIT: An upright growth habit and dark green, highly disease tolerant foliage give form and substance to the summer garden.

CULTURE: Adaptable to diverse soil, moisture, and climate conditions. Requires very little pruning to maintain its shape nor chemical controls. Effective for foundation plantings or formal gardens; as a specimen for space-limited situations; a strong focal accent in the shrub border or residential garden

GROWTH RATE: Slow to moderate growth rate.
