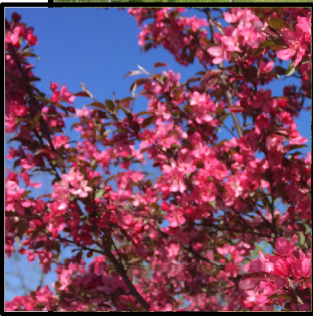

LEAF - Summer Dark Red



**LEAF COLOR:** A deep purple foliage all summer long, with unique deeply lobed cutleaf leaves. Fall foliage turns bright pinkish red-orange, showing the attractive red-maroon berries persistent into winter. Very attractive to birds.

**FRUIT - Fall - Winter**

**HABIT:** Upright oval-round form with good branching and density, inherited from its Golden Raindrop parent.

**GROWTH RATE:** Medium plus growth rate.

**FLOWER:** Showy middle to late season Dark red buds opening to fuchsia pink to paler pink as flowers fade.

**FRUIT:** 1/4" bright red late in spring, persisting into winter darker red.
