

LEAF COLOR: A deep purple foliage all summer long, with unique deeply lobed cutleaf leaves. Fall foliage turns bright pinkish red-orange, showing the attractive red-maroon berries perisitant into winter. Very attractive to birds


FRUIT - Fall - Winter



GROWTH RATE: Medium plus growth rate.

FLOWER: Showy middle to late season Dark red buds opening to fuchsia pink to paler pink as flowers fade.

FRUIT: 1/4" bright red late in sping, persisting into
