LEAF COLOR: Compound, Course dark green leaves. Palm shaped.

HABIT: A small rounded tree.

CULTURE: Red Horsechestnut tend to be more tolerant of drought, than common horsechestnut.

GROWTH RATE: Slow to medium.

FLOWER: Deep pink with a yellow throat.
Favored by hummingbirds.

FRUIT: Capsule, 1-1.5" long, round husks light brown, prickly, seed glossy brown.

Other Characteristics: Fort McNair selected at the fort of the same name in Washington D.C.
