HABIT: Light-shaded, a delicate and sophisticated silhouette easy clean up in the fall. Prune to establish a sound structure, very hard wood. Good salt tolerance.

CULTURE: Withstands a wide range of conditions, clay, loam, sand tolerant of urban conditions. Reaches maximum development on rich, moist bottomlands or soils of a limestone origin; drought tolerant once established; prune in fall.


