LEAF COLOR: Outstanding dark glossy smooth leaves in the summer changes to tints of yellow, and orange with red highlights

HABIT: Upright spreading rounded crown. Full sun

CULTURE: Adaptable to heat and drought and varied growing conditions. Pacific Sunset Maple (Acer truncatum x A. plat. 'warrenred' P.P. No 7433) is a hybrid of Acer Platanoides (Norway) that combines the best characteristics of the parents is a medium sized shade tree. The parent Norway contributes to faster growth, caliper development at an early age, and larger leaves.

GROWTH RATE: Medium+ (like Norway maple)

FRUIT: "wings"
