HABIT: Upright columnar

CULTURE: Readily transplanted because of shallow, fibrous root system; will tolerate wet soils and is found in the wild on wet clay flats where water may stand for several weeks; actually prefers moist rich, acid well-drained soil; very tolerant of high ph soils.

FRUIT: Nut, mature in second year.
