LEAF COLOR: Needles 3/4" - 1 1/4" long, rigid, stout, very prickly, gray-green to blue-green needles. Young growth soft, silvery blue-gray.

HABIT: A dense, regular narrow to broad pyramid with horizontal stiff branches to the ground.

CULTURE: Prefers well drained rich, moist soil. Does not like to be wet for a period of time.

GROWTH RATE: Slow-medium (30' in 35 yrs)

FRUIT: Cones oblong, 2" to 5" long, 1 to 1 1/4" wide, green with violet bloom when young, turning light or yellow-brown when ripe.
