## COURSE DIRECTIONS.

START at roadside reflector post opposite " Road Narrows " warning post near railway bridge on the Stonebridge-Castle Bromwich Road 1000 yards north of Stonebridge. Proceed to Bacon's End and past the back of " Bradford Arms " to Castle Bromwich. TURN in line with field gate opposite Hall Road and RETRACE past starting point to Stonebridge. Turn LEFT to Meriden, round island to right, and at end of lane turn left on to Kenilworth Road to Donkey Hill. Turn in line with **telegraph pole No. 20** and go direct to Stonebridge, FINISHING AT WHITE FENCE POST 30 yards before **telegraph pole No. 290** and 250 yards before the Birmingham-Coventry Road.

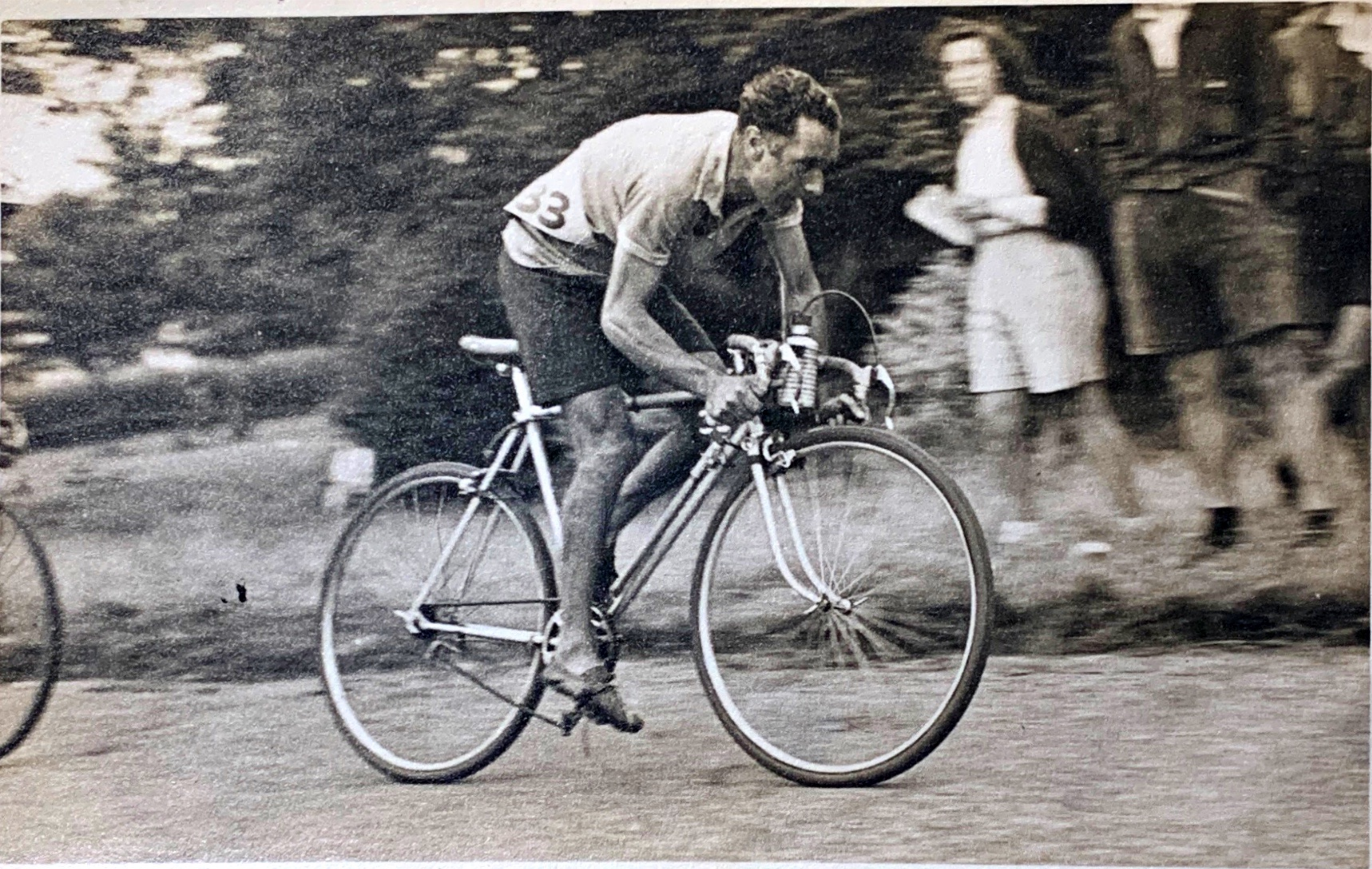


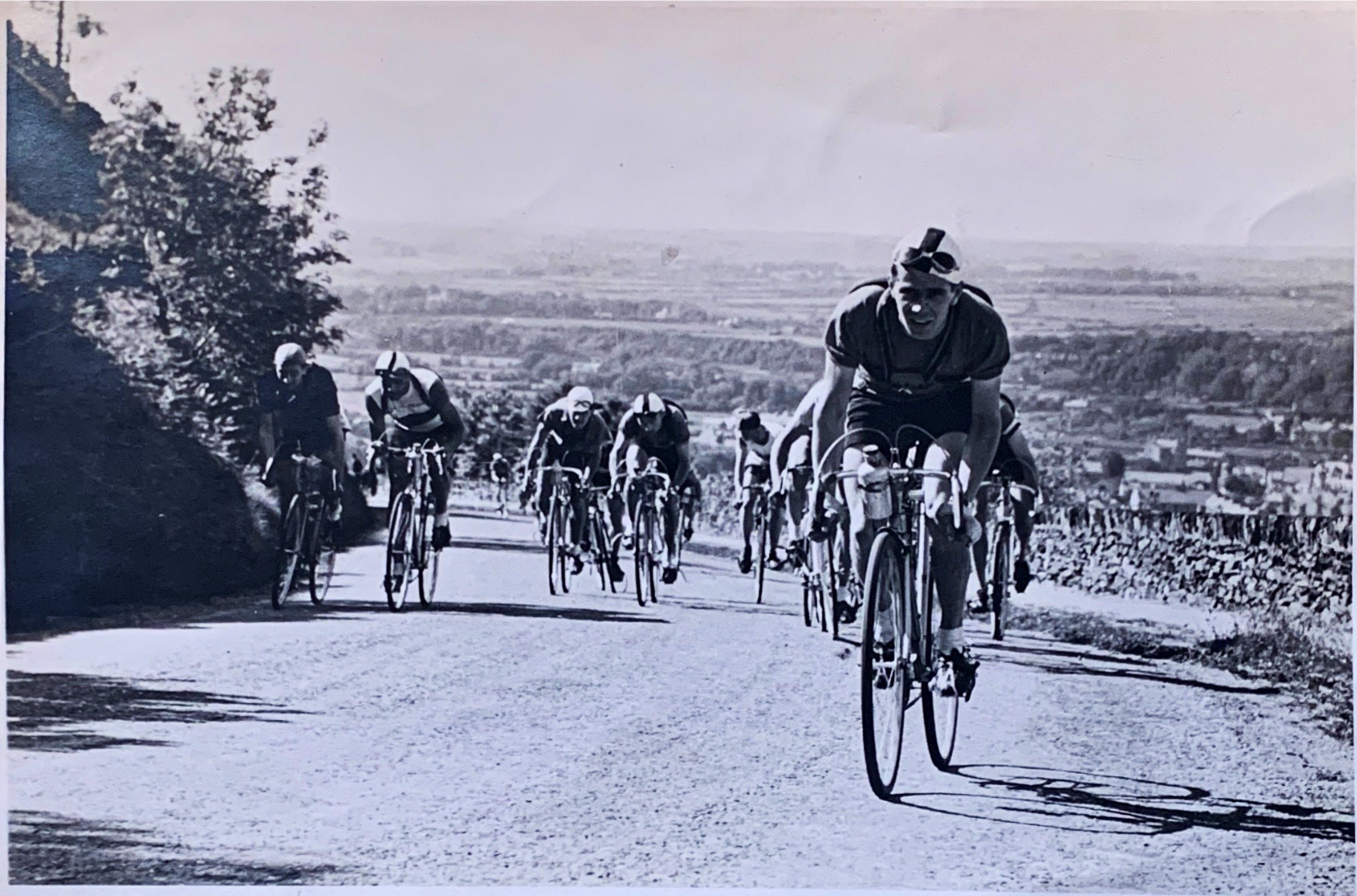


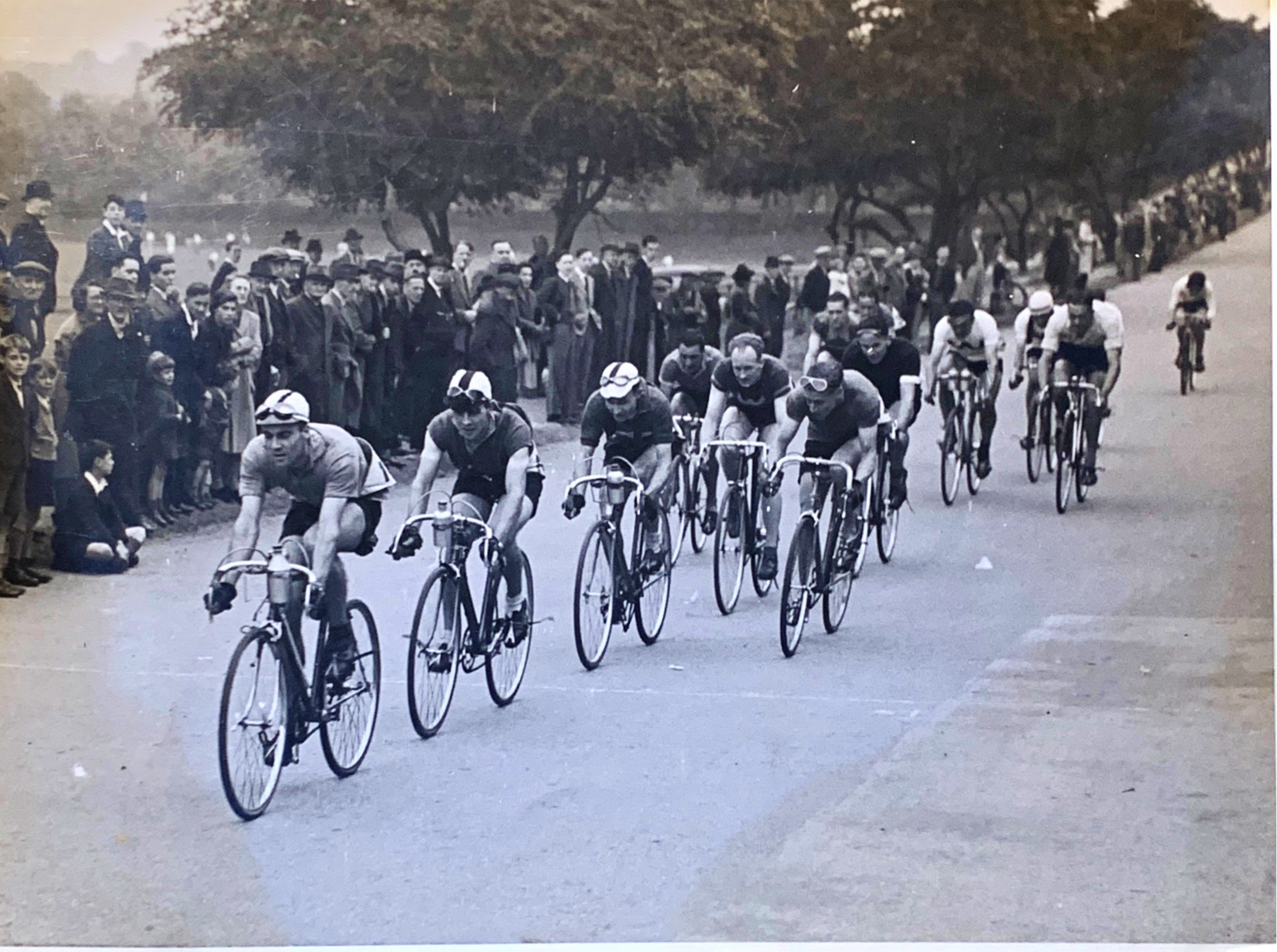
