Honorary Life Member Policy

This Policy sets out the minimum criteria to qualify for an honorary life membership in the

Irish Sports and Social Society

Criteria

1.General

The candidate, as an ambassador of the ISSS

- -should display great character general attitude and behavior
- -show a dedication to the goals and values of the ISSS and
- -display good leadership and role modelling which reflects credit upon the ISSS

2.Length of service

To be eligible for the award the candidate must have a minimum of 20 years continuous membership in the ISSS

OR

A. Served at least one term as president of the ISSS

OR

B. Served at least 3 years as Vice President, Treasurer or other signing officer of the ISSS

OR

- C. Made an extraordinary voluntary contribution to the Society which goes above and beyond the normal role of an ordinary member
 - 1. Areas of contribution might include, help at heritage days, maintenance and repair, help with cleaning, set up of hall for functions, helping in kitchen or bar, yard maintenance, mowing lawns, shoveling snow etc.

Benefits of being an honorary life member

- 1. Exemption from fees associated with membership of the ISSS
- 2. Exemption from costs of social functions eg Annual Dinner Dance (does not extend to guests)

Nominations for Honorary lifetime membership must be proposed and seconded by 2 current members of the Society and submitted to the executive for consideration

The lifetime honorary membership certificate will be awarded at the AGM or other suitable occasion whenever possible

The executive will make the final decision on recipients at the last regular meeting of their term
