### **Wavaires Celebrate 50 Years**

In the 1970-71 School year, the Choral Department was headed by **Mr. Edward Reck**, and consisted of an Advanced Choir, Girls' Glee Club, and Training Choir. Mr. Reck reorganized the classes in this discipline the next school year, 1971-72, and developed an advanced group chosen by tryouts. This group met five days a week and correlated choreography with their songs. Chairs were removed from their classroom to force students to be more alert and to support their tone better. This new group was called the **Wavaires** and was added to the GHS musical roster of Girls' Glee Club and General Choir, which already existed. They put on a community Christmas concert at the Methodist Church. The boys in the Wavaires collected a love offering in the church and donated the money to the pediatrics ward at Wayne Hospital.

All choirs were under new leadership the next year, 1972-73, when **Mrs. Marilyn Light** became choral director. The Wavaires expanded with performances in the Darke County Home, community church service, the Doyle Brumbaugh Benefit Fund, singing Christmas carols at the Court House, and at the Homecoming Banquet.

Mr. David Priebe took over and directed eight vocal groups in 1975-76: Mixed Choir, Wavaires, Junior and Senior Girls' Glee, plus four ensembles: Junior Girls' Ensemble, Sophomore Girls' Ensemble, Senior Girls' Ensemble, and Boys Ensemble. He added students to direct the students in some of the classes: Craig Brown GHS 1976 of Mixed Choir and Beth Schatz GHS 1977 of Girls' Glee. Mr. Priebe had two goals in teaching vocal music. One was to teach musical skills such as tone and blending with the rest of the choir, and the other was to make the students more aware of music as an art form.

The 1976-77 year brought the return of Marilyn Light to head the choral department. She had five groups: Girls' Glee, Mixed Choir, Wavaires, Boys Ensemble, and Girls Ensemble. Students had a candy sale to raise funds and David Browne GHS 1977 was president of the department. The Wavaires were made up of Juniors and Seniors, Their activities included performing at various clubs and organizations in addition to the Winter Musical and Choir-O-Rama.

The 1978 musical groups performed "Bye Bye Birdie" and in the Winter Musical and Choir-O-Rama. They added church services to their agenda of shows and attended the District Contest.

A new era began in 1978-79 when **Miss Michele Smith** became leader of all the vocal groups. During the 83-year period of 1930 to 2013, two teachers led the GHS choral department for 73 of those 83 years: **Miss Elizabeth Hill** from 1930 to 1968 and **Miss Michele Smith** from 1978 to 2013.

The 1980 vocal music department consisted of the same five groups as in previous years and gave 40 to 50 performances for various civic organizations, an elementary school tour, a County Choral Festival, the Good Friday Community Service, GHS musicals, and competed in the state contest and Solo and Ensemble competition. Students raised \$2,000 selling candy and \$700 from poster sales. The May Choir-O-Rama was a resounding success and Wavaires performances include selections from "The Wiz", "Breakfast at Tiffany's", "Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band", "The Muppet Movie", and other movie themes.






