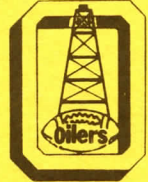

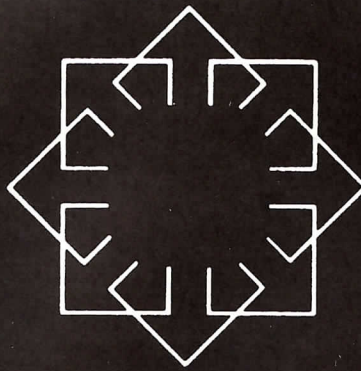

Leading the way, the offensive line is the Oilers' best ever. Back this year is the unit of John Carter, Stan Brown, Steve Bruning and Carl Titus with experienced Wally Raines replacing Leo Venezia. They will all be pushed for their starting jobs by veterans Bob Gibson, Dennis Bruning, and John Caprigno; new-comers Paul Zito and Bob Capachione; and rookie Pat Merrick.

At Quarterback will be converted tight end Tim Countie, Veterans John Amicangioli and Ralph Pina, or Phil Wilson who was coaxed out of retirement.

Catching the ball is a group that would make any team envious. Veteran tight end Phil Fruzzetti has to look over his shoulder for rookie Mark Murphy. On the outside, veterans Mike Delancey and Bruce Fisher have to watch out for returning Rick Smith and newly acquired Terry Moore and Bill Toth.

On the ground, Phil Warsheski and Ed Nelson, who have always been among the league's rushing leaders, are being hard pressed for starting roles by veteran Scott Slattery, newly acquired Huck Tyler and an excellent crop of rookies that includes Dave Buron, George Gardiner John D'Antuono and Wendell Lindsey.

The kicking game should rank among the league's best with the addition of NFL hopeful Brian Daniell who has been splitting the uprights from up to 50 yards in practice.

Up front the defense could start a unit that averages 256 lbs. Anchored by Steve Venckus, this stalwart group includes veterans Chuck Reinbold, Jack Lankiewicz and Steve Foley and newcomers Scott Hittinger, Steve Garrod, Dave Audette and Al McDonald.

The super linebacking corps is led by Bubba Pina and Lorne Beane. The return of Mike Issler and Kevin Mahoney and the addition of Mike Frammartino, Chuck Connolly, and Bob Pedicini gives the Oilers size, speed and depth - even more if Henry Kalwicz returns.

A hard hitting secondary rounds out the '82 Oilers. All are veterans except Cliff Parrott and with so much talent, it will be hard to pick a starting unit from John Berry, Dave Fernandes, Greg Deschenes, Butch Stearns, Paul Martin, Jim Brodie, Lou DeMarco, Scott Solomon, or Bernie Silva. Whoever starts, the Oilers probably won't be beaten deep very often.
